## SHIPPING STATISTICS

October, 1957

The total volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during October amounted to 17,339,-080 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports declined 12.9 per cent to 5,220,957 tons from 5,992,360 one year ago, while cargo received from foreign ports dropped 10.3 per cent to 4,357,921 tons from 4,861,-194 in October, 1956. Vessels in coastal trade reported loadings and unloadings of 3,587,651 and 4,-172,551 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 4.2 per cent from the 1956 total of 4,354,155 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the period January - October amounted to 135,478,-138 tons. Of this total, 76,633,288 tons were loaded or unloaded in foreign trade and 58,844,850 tons in coastal trade. In the like period of 1956 waterborne exports and imports totalled 77,951,792 tons. Tonnage of coastwise shipments is not available.

Vessel arrivals and departures at Canadian ports totalled 25,129 in October as against 24,488 in the same month last year. Registered net tonnage rose to 28,415,754 tons from 27,938,997. For the period January - October, arrivals and departures numbered 225,342 as compared with 209,981 one year ago.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during the month of October amounted to 5,077,352 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,541,955 tons, and at Pacific coast ports 1,189,301 tons. Unloadings were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 4,512,555 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 3,299,897 tons and the Pacific coast with 718,020 tons.

The principal commodities loaded for foreign ports in the month of October were: iron ore, 2,611,732 tons; wheat, 400,621 tons; gypsum, 335,738 tons; newsprint paper, 233,217 tons; pulpwood, 196,936 tons; and lumber, 188,110 tons. More than half of the total cargo received was made up of bituminous coal, (1,690,386 tons), iron ore, (479,657 tons) and crude oil, (395,264 tons). In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore and petroleum products.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during October were: Seven Islands, 2,111,702 tons; Montreal, 1,678,238 tons; Hamilton, 1,003,284 tons; Port Arthur, 978,879 tons; Vancouver, 837,115 tons; Toronto, 546,443 tons; Sault Ste. Marie, 530,768 tons and Quebec, 506,539 tons.

Cargo loaded at Montreal for foreign ports declined to 478,242 tons from 1,055,482 in October last year. A large part of this decrease is attributable to shipments of iron ore which, with the inclusion of non-customs ports in the 1957 statistics, are now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. The balance of the decline was mainly due to a decrease in loadings of wheat which fell to 114,290 tons from 204,655 tons last year. Decreases in unloadings of bituminous coal and crude oil were mainly responsible for the decline in goods received from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service again reported slight decreases in loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands and Port Arthur as well as reduced unloadings at Hamilton and Sault Ste. Marie. Other principal changes affecting the ports under review included a decrease in wheat shipped from Vancouver, and petroleum products unloaded at Vancouver and Quebec. Unloadings of bituminous coal were down at Port Arthur and Toronto. A slight increase in iron, pig and bloom, was also recorded in loadings at Sault Ste. Marie.

Note: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
