SHIPPING STATISTICS

November, 1957

The total volume of freight loaded and unloaded during the month of November amounted to 14,364,106 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports declined 4.0 per cent to 4,069,497 tons from 4,237,333 one year ago, while cargo received from foreign ports dropped 22.8 per cent to 3,221,704 tons from 4,174,194 in November, 1956. Vessels in coastal trade reported loadings and unloadings of 3,453,065 and 3,619,840 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 5.6 per cent from the 1956 total of 3,835,515 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the period January-November amounted to 149,842,244 tons. Of this total, 83,924,489 tons were loaded or unloaded in foreign trade and 65,917,755 tons in coastal trade. In the like period of 1956 waterborne exports and imports totalled 86,363,319 tons. Tonnage of coastwise shipments for 1956 is not available.

Vessel arrivals and departures at Canadian ports totalled 24,178 in November as against 20,208 in the same month last year. Registered net tonnage dropped to 23,631,954 tons from 25,043,386. For the period January-November, arrivals and departures numbered 249,520 as compared with 230,189 one year ago.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during the month of November amounted to 3,333,825 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,797,992 tons, and at Pacific coast ports 1,390,745 tons. Unloadings, on the other hand, were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 3,176,206 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 2,976,459 tons and the Pacific coast with 688,879 tons.

Commodities loaded in largest volume for foreign ports during November were: iron ore, 1,089,561 tons; wheat, 833,889 tons; lumber, 196,925 tons; barley, 195,848 tons; and newsprint, 185,885 tons. Of total cargo received from foreign ports more than half was accounted for by shipments of bituminous coal at 1,127,840 tons, petroleum products at 452,944 tons and crude petroleum, 341,899 tons. In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, barley, and gasoline.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during November were: Montreal, 2,247,064 tons; Vancouver, 1,032,456 tons; Port Arthur, 839,755 tons; Fort William, 687,537 tons; Seven Islands, 578,179 tons and Quebec, 522,169 tons.

Cargo loaded at Montreal for foreign ports declined to 590,558 from 848,579 tons in November last year. Approximately half of this decrease is attributable to iron ore which, with the inclusion of non-customs ports in the 1957 statistics, are now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. The balance of the decline was mainly due to a decrease in loadings of wheat which fell to 195,247 tons from 222,621 tons last year. Decreases in unloadings of bituminous coal, anthracite coal and petroleum products were mainly responsible for the decline in goods received from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service again reported slight decreases in loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands and Port Arthur. Other principal changes affecting the ports under review included an increase in wheat shipped from Vancouver and Quebec as well as increased loadings of oats and barley at Fort William. Unloadings of bituminous coal were down at Port Arthur and Quebec. A slight decrease in petroleum products was also recorded for Quebec.

Note: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
