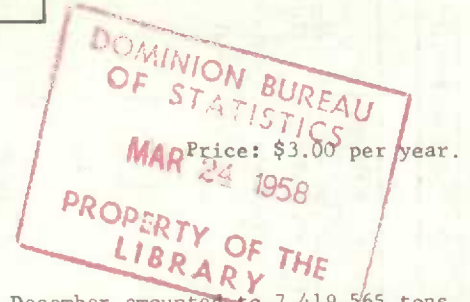

SHIPPING STATISTICS

December, 1957



The total volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during December amounted to 7,419,565 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports declined slightly to 2,510,389 tons from 2,526,254 one year ago, while cargo received from foreign ports dropped 33.1 per cent to 1,311,708 tons from 1,960,256. Vessels in coastal trade reported loadings and unloadings of 1,607,521 tons and 1,989,947 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 16.3 per cent from the 1956 total of 2,378,585 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the year amounted to 157,261,809 tons as compared with 163,489,774 in 1956. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade decreased 2.4 per cent to 87,746,586 tons from 89,927,444 while freight handled in coastal trade dropped 5.5 per cent to 69,515,223 tons from 73,562,330 tons one year ago.

Vessel arrivals and departures at Canadian ports totalled 14,602 in December as against 15,467 in the same month last year while registered net tonnage rose to 16,860,853 tons from 16,693,377. During the year 1957 arrivals and departures in both services numbered 264,122 as compared with 250,897 in 1956.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during December amounted to 2,015,610 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 968,149 tons, and at Pacific coast ports 1,134,151 tons. Unloadings were heaviest in the Atlantic region with 1,505,096 tons followed by the Great Lakes area with 1,345,198 tons, and the Pacific coast with 451,361 tons.

The principal commodities loaded for foreign ports in the month of December were: wheat, 570,604 tons; gypsum, 328,749 tons; iron ore, 264,013 tons; and lumber, 201,864 tons. Of total cargo received from foreign ports more than half was accounted for by shipments of crude oil at 243,746 tons, petroleum products at 232,327 tons, bituminous coal at 134,551 tons and bauxite 63,022 tons. In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, gasoline, and sand, gravel and crushed stone.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during December were: Vancouver, 919,741 tons; Montreal, 734,306 tons; Halifax, 662,304 tons; Port Arthur, 401,353 tons; Saint John, 315,737 tons; Toronto, 281,378 tons; Bell Island, 243,405 tons and Fort William 203,673 tons.

Cargo loaded at Montreal for foreign ports declined to 274,978 tons from 314,036 in December last year. Part of this decrease is attributable to reduced shipments of wheat which fell to 81,669 from 99,444 tons and petroleum products which dropped to 1,682 from 14,000 tons. Other principal changes affecting the ports under review were an increase in loadings of iron ore at Bell Island and a decrease in bituminous coal unloaded at Toronto.

The figures quoted for the year 1957 are subject to revision in the annual "Shipping Report".

Note: Beginning with January, 1957, statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
