SHIPPING STATISTICS

MAY, 1957

Beginning this month a supplement list of ports has been added to table 6, page 8, which gives commodity detail for cargoes unloaded and loaded at selected Canadian ports.

The total volume of freight transported during May, amounted to 19,415,654 tons, 10,468,048 in foreign service and 8,947,606 in coastwise service. Cargo tonnage for the period January - May totalled 41,295,130. Of this amount 23,122,431 tons were handled in foreign service against 22,689,029 tons in the same period last year. No comparable figure is available for coastwise trade. Unloadings in foreign traffic increased to 5,088,869 tons from 4,529,059 in May, 1956, a gain of 559,810 tons or 12.3 per cent, while loadings rose to 5,379,179 from 5,322,443 up 56,736 tons or 1.0 per cent. In coastwise service unloadings rose to 4,607,185 tons from 4,506,232 in 1956, a rise of 100,953 tons or 2.2 per cent. Loadings equalled 4,340,421 tons. Comparable data on 1956 loadings are not available.

During May, the number of vessels arriving and departing in foreign and coastwise service increased to 27,787 from 26,957 in 1956, while the registered net tonnage dropped to 30,167,745 from 30,604,219. For the period January - May, 82,344 vessels are recorded as having arrived and departed as compared with 79,307 last year, an increase of 3,037 vessels.

Atlantic and St. Lawrence River ports reported unloadings of 1,436,574 against loadings of 3,068,660 tons in foreign service while a total of 3,653,465 was handled in coastwise trade. At Pacific Coast ports 912,834 tons were unloaded and 1,830,654 loaded in foreign and coastwise service. In the Great Lakes area 3,422,959 tons were unloaded and 1,173,232 loaded in foreign service while coastwise service accounted for 1,806,989 tons unloaded and 2,110,287 loaded.

Commodities which moved in greatest volume in foreign service included iron ore, 688,158 tons, bituminous coal, 2,361,776, crude oil, 341,498 and bauxite 379,088 tons, accounting for more than half of the total unloaded while 612,466 tons of wheat and 2,485,731 tons of iron ore were responsible for 57.6 per cent of total cargo loaded. In coastwise service the heaviest volume was recorded in wheat, barley, pulpwood, iron ore and petroleum products.

The port of Montreal registered the greatest volume of shipping in May with total cargo amounting to 1,810,113 tons. Vessels in foreign service unloaded and loaded a total of 743,353 tons as compared with 1,446,651 in May, 1956, a decrease of 703,298 tons; coastwise shipping totalled 1,066,760 tons. Seven Islands came second with a total of 1,610,588 tons, shipments of iron ore alone accounting for 1,580,195 tons. Port Arthur stood in third place with a cargo movement of 1,575,139 tons. A total of 727,616 was unloaded and loaded in foreign service as compared with 501,022 tons last year. Cargoes handled in coastwise service totalled 847,523 tons. Vancouver reported 1,438,445 tons for the month. Vessels in foreign service unloaded 112,440 tons as compared with 123,162 in May, 1956, a decrease of 10,722 tons, while loadings rose to 786,204 from 549,839 tons, up by 236,365. In coastwise service vessels unloaded 221,948 tons against 317,853 loaded. Sault Ste. Marie loaded and unloaded a total of 780,702 tons in foreign and coastwise service, wheat shipments accounting for 288,584, iron ore, 297,592 and limestone 85,581. Halifax handled a total of 609,911 for the month. Vessels in foreign service unloaded 328,379 tons and loaded 144,374 at Halifax while vessels in coastwise service unloaded 14,447 against 122,711 tons loaded. Quebec reported 519,638 tons for the month. Unloadings totalled 397,617 tons including 131,093 tons of pulpwood, 149,046 tons of petroleum products and 39,610 tons of gasoline. Cargoes loaded amounted to 122,021 tons. At Toronto a total of 514,055 was unloaded and 130,080 loaded, while Prescott reported unloadings of 234,550 and loadings of 87,117 tons. Bell Island handled 329,687 tons during May, shipments of iron ore accounting for 329,284 tons. Victoria recorded a total of 163,878 tons for the month.

NOTE: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
