

SHIPPING STATISTICS

JUNE, 1957



The total volume of freight loaded or unloaded at Canadian ports during the month of June amounted to 19,718,070 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports declined 1.7 p.c. to 5,892,477 tons from 5,993,749 in the corresponding month one year ago while cargo received from foreign ports advanced 6.0 p.c. to 5,213,355 tons from 4,919,845 in June 1956. Vessels in coastwise service reported loadings and unloadings of 3,971,724 and 4,640,514 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 7.8 p.c. from the June 1956 total of 5,033,081 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the first half of 1957 amounted to 61,013,200 tons. Of this amount 34,228,263 tons were loaded or unloaded in foreign service and 26,784,937 tons in coastwise service. While comparable data are not available for cargo handled in coastwise service, cargo handled in foreign service during the first six months of 1956 amounted to 33,602,623 tons.

Arrivals and departures of vessels in foreign and coastwise service totalled 30,397 in June as against 27,021 in the comparable month one year ago. Registered net tonnage of the vessels involved rose to 31,936,388 from 31,744,648 tons. During the first six months of 1957 arrivals and departures in both services numbered 112,741 as compared with 106,328 vessels in the like period of 1956.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during the month of June amounted to 5,733,631 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,709,416 tons and Pacific coast ports 1,421,154 tons. Unloadings, on the other hand, were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 5,155,678 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 3,842,138 tons and the Pacific coast with 856,053 tons.

The principal commodities loaded for foreign ports in the month of June were: iron ore, 2,937,383 tons; wheat, 721,953 tons; gypsum, 392,582 tons; and newsprint paper, 255,449 tons. Of total cargo received from foreign ports more than half is accounted for in unloadings of 2,404,691 tons of bituminous coal, 844,397 tons of iron ore and 287,559 tons of crude oil. In coastwise service the greater volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore and petroleum products.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during the month of June included Montreal with 2,172,487 tons; Seven Islands, 2,077,487 tons; Hamilton, 1,212,024 tons; Port Arthur, 1,179,715 tons; Vancouver, 1,142,645 tons; and Sault Ste. Marie, 752,345 tons.

Although cargo loaded for foreign countries at the Port of Montreal is recorded as having declined to 638,817 tons from 1,211,485 one year earlier, approximately half of the decrease is attributable to shipments of iron ore which with the inclusion of non custom ports in 1957 statistics are now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. The balance of the decline is mainly due to decreased loadings of wheat which fell to 239,602 tons from 503,810 tons one year earlier. Decreased unloadings of crude oil were largely responsible for the decline in cargo received from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service reported greatly increased loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands, but reduced loadings at Port Arthur. Iron ore unloaded in foreign service, on the other hand, declined at Sault Ste. Marie but rose at Hamilton. Other principal changes affecting the ports under review are a decline in wheat shipments from Vancouver, and increases in bituminous coal unloaded at Sault Ste. Marie and at Hamilton. Comparable data for vessels in coastal trade are not available.

NOTE: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
