SHIPPING STATISTICS

JULY, 1957

Vessel loadings and unloadings of freight at Canadian ports during July amounted to 20,513,335 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports increased 12.6 per cent to 6,426,400 from 5,705,886 tons in the corresponding month last year while cargo received from foreign ports advanced moderately to 5,037,640 from 5,015,933 tons. In coastal movements of freight, 4,109,806 tons were reported as loaded and 4,939,489 tons as unloaded. Unloadings were down 10.4 per cent from last year; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the period January - July amounted to 81,526,535 tons. Of this total, 45,692,303 tons represent goods leaving or entering Canada and 35,834,232 tons goods being moved from one Canadian port to another. In the like period of 1956 waterborne exports and imports totalled 44,324,442 tons. Tonnage of coastwise shipments is not available.

Vessel arrivals and departures at Canadian ports totalled 31,388 in July as against 27,497 in the same month last year with registered net tonnage rising to 32,916,939 from 32,372,436 tons. For the period January - July, arrivals and departures numbered 144,129 as compared with 133,825 one year ago.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and St. Lawrence River ports during July amounted to 6,199,939 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,908,915 tons, and at Pacific coast ports 1,427,352 tons. Unloadings were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 4,905,181 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 4,392,419 tons and the Pacific coast with 679,529 tons.

Commodities loaded in largest volume for foreign ports during July were: iron ore, 3,725,524 tons; wheat, 551,729 tons; gypsum, 341,873 tons; and newsprint paper, 250,609 tons. Of total cargo received from foreign ports more than half is accounted for in unloadings of 1,848,558 tons of bituminous coal, 954,792 tons of iron ore, 475,556 tons of crude oil and 351,578 tons of petroleum products. In coastwise trade, the greater volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore and petroleum products.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during July were: Seven Islands, 2,626,119 tons; Montreal, 2,392,861 tons; Port Arthur, 1,149,046 tons; Hamilton, 1,113,379 tons; Vancouver, 1,046,080 tons; and Toronto, 783,157 tons.

Cargo loaded at Montreal for foreign ports declined to 513,218 tons from 1,080,206 in July last year. Approximately half of this decrease is attributable to shipments of iron ore which, with the inclusion of non-customs ports in the 1957 statistics, are now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. The balance of the decline was mainly due to a decrease in loadings of wheat which fell to 139,850 tons from 358,107 tons in the same month last year. A decrease in unloadings of crude oil was again responsible for most of the decline in receipts from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service reported increased loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands but reduced loadings at Port Arthur, while iron ore unloaded at Hamilton more than doubled, rising to 593,525 tons from 220,057 tons in July, 1956. Other significant changes affecting the ports under review included a sharp decline in unloadings of bituminous coal at Hamilton and an increase in wheat shipped from Vancouver. Comparable data for vessels in coastal trade are not available.

NOTE: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
