AUGUST, 1957

The total volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during August amounted to 19,082,990 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports increased 2.7 per cent to 6,062,494 tons from 5,902,011 in the corresponding month one year ago while cargo received from foreign ports declined 8.1 per cent to 4,984,558 tons from 5,422,781 in August 1956. Vessels in coastal trade reported loadings and unloadings of 3,609,380 and 4,426,558 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 5.7 per cent from the August 1956 total of 4,695,775 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the period January - August amounted to 100,609,525 tons. Of this total, 56,739,355 tons represents goods leaving or entering Canada and 43,870,170 tons goods being shipped from one Canadian port to another. In the like period of 1956 waterborne exports and imports totalled 55,649,234 tons. Tonnage of coastwise shipments is not available.

Vessel arrivals and departures at Canadian ports totalled 30,671 in August as against 27,717 in the same month last year with registered net tonnage rising to 32,065,033 from 31,671,720 tons. For the period January - August, arrivals and departures numbered 174,800 as compared with 161,542 one year ago.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during August amounted to 6,110,857 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,200,455 tons, and at Pacific coast ports 1,360,562 tons. Unloadings were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 4,708,458 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 3,879,627 tons and the Pacific coast with 823,031 tons.

The principal commodities loaded for foreign ports in the month of August were: iron ore, 3,397,282 tons; wheat, 592,723 tons; gypsum, 442,256 tons; pulpwood, 232,860 tons; and newsprint paper, 222,500 tons. More than half of the total cargo received was made up of bituminous coal, (2,101,548 tons) and iron ore (837,033 tons). In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore and petroleum products.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during August were: Seven Islands, 2,676,144 tons; Montreal, 2,132,593 tons; Hamilton, 1,110,223 tons; Vancouver, 1,036,868 tons; Port Arthur, 776,881 tons; Sault Ste. Marie, 770,695; and Toronto, 632,729 tons.

Cargo loaded for foreign ports at Montreal declined to 422,664 tons from 765,463 in August last year. Approximately half of this decrease is attributable to iron ore which, with the inclusion of non-customs ports in the 1957 statistics, is now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. Decreases in unloadings of bituminous coal, anthracite coal and crude oil were mainly responsible for the decline in goods received from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service again reported greatly increased loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands, but reduced loadings at Port Arthur, while iron ore unloaded at Hamilton increased to 539,946 tons from 395,653 tons in August, 1956. Other principal changes affecting the ports under review included a slight decrease in wheat shipped from Vancouver, and decreases in bituminous coal unloaded at Port Arthur and Toronto. Comparable data for vessels in coastal trade are not available.

NOTE: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
