

## SHIPPING STATISTICS

September, 1957

The total volume of freight loaded or unloaded during the month of September amounted to 17,- 529,533 tons. Cargo destined to foreign ports declined 8.8 per cent to 5,669,855 tons from 6,219,- 300 one year ago, while cargo received from foreign ports decreased 11.2 per cent to 4,645,200 tons from 5,229,704 in September 1956. Vessels in coastal trade reported loadings and unloadings of 3,304,621 and 3,909,857 tons respectively. The latter figure represents a decline of 2.3 per cent from the September 1956 total of 4,002,947 tons; comparable data on loadings are not available.

Cargo handled at Canadian ports during the period January - September amounted to 118,- 139,058 tons. Of this amount, 67,054,410 tons were loaded or unloaded in foreign trade and 51,084,- 648 tons in coastal trade. In the like period of 1956 waterborne exports and imports totalled 67,- 098,238 tons. Tonnage of coastwise shipments is not available.

Arrivals and departures of vessels at Canadian ports totalled 25,413 in September as against 23,951 in the comparable month one year ago. Registered net tonnage of the vessels involved dropped to 28,491,880 from 28,642,235 tons. For the period January - September, 200,213 vessels are recorded as having arrived and departed as compared with 185,493 last year.

Cargo loaded at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports during the month of September amounted to 5,562,543 tons, at Great Lakes and upper St. Lawrence River ports 2,073,397 tons and Pacific coast ports 1,338,536 tons. Unloadings, on the other hand, were heaviest in the Great Lakes area with 4,156,444 tons followed by the Atlantic region with 3,659,608 tons and the Pacific coast with 739,005 tons.

Commodities loaded in largest volume for foreign ports during September were: iron ore, 2,922,387 tons; wheat, 669,402 tons; gypsum, 370,477 tons; and pulpwood 260,406 tons. Of total cargo received from foreign ports more than half is accounted for in unloadings of 1,809,130 tons of bituminous coal and 735,563 tons of iron ore. In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore, bituminous coal and petroleum products.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo handled during September were: Seven Islands, 2,328,249 tons; Montreal, 1,979,635 tons; Hamilton, 993,905 tons; Vancouver, 991,761 tons; Port Arthur, 772,956 tons; Sault Ste. Marie, 563,773 tons; Halifax, 547,064 tons; and Toronto 524,342 tons.

Cargo loaded at Montreal for foreign ports declined to 366,862 tons from 777,989 in September last year. A large part of this decrease is attributable to shipments of iron ore which, with the inclusion of non-customs ports in the 1957 statistics are now credited to the port of Contrecoeur. The balance of the decline was mainly due to a decrease in loadings of wheat which fell to 75,301 tons from 132,084 tons last year. Decreases in unloadings of bituminous coal and crude oil were mainly responsible for the decline in goods received from foreign ports.

Vessels in foreign service reported slight decreases in loadings of iron ore at Seven Islands and Port Arthur as well as reduced unloadings at Hamilton and Sault Ste. Marie. Other significant changes affecting the ports under review included an increase in wheat shipped from Vancouver, and petroleum products unloaded at Vancouver, Halifax and Toronto. Unloadings of bituminous coal were down at Port Arthur but up at Toronto. Comparable data for vessels in coastal trade are not available.

Note: Beginning this year statistics are being collected from vessels in coastwise service departing from non-customs ports.
