SHIPPING STATISTICS

October, 1958

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during October totalled 17,078,689 tons, 1.5 per cent below the 17,339,080 tons reported for October last year. Cargoes loaded in foreign trade declined by 4.1 per cent to 5,005,648 tons from 5,220,957 while unloadings fell 8.9 per cent, dropping to 3,969,960 tons from 4,357,921. In coastal trade, loadings increased to 4,017,930 tons from 3,587,651 while unloadings decreased to 4,085,151 tons from 4,172,551. For the period January-October, cargoes handled at Canadian ports were 11.9 per cent below last year, dropping to 119,412,785 tons from 135,478,138. Cargoes handled in foreign trade decreased to 60,785,198 tons from 76,633,288 and in coastal trade to 58,627,587 tons from 58,844,850. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services decreased to 24,730 from 25,129 in October, 1957, while registered net tonnage rose to 28,827,007 tons from 28,415,754. For the period January-October the number of arrivals and departures decreased by 13,624.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, lumber and newsprint. As compared with October, 1957, loadings of wheat were up by 315,898 tons, lumber by 60,882 tons and woodpulp by 33,867 tons. These increases were offset by a decrease in iron one of 420,316 tons. Other decreases were recorded in shipments of gypsum, pulpwood and general cargo, resulting in a net decline of 215,309 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign ports were down by 387,961 tons. The largest decreases were in bituminous coal which dropped to 1,403,787 tons from 1,690,386 and in bauxite down to 240,126 tons from 307,186.

In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, pulpwood and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of wheat, bituminous coal, sand, gravel and crushed stone, and gasoline were higher than in the previous year, decreases in pulpwood and iron ore resulted in an overall decline this October of 87,400 tons.

Loadings were down 7.2 per cent to 4,712,430 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region but up 19.2 per cent to 1,417,644 tons on the Pacific coast and 13.8 per cent to 2,893,504 tons in the Great Lakes area. Unloadings showed an increase of 4.5 per cent to 3,447,473 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region and 9.2 per cent to 783,824 tons on the Pacific coast but a drop of 15.3 per cent to 3,823,814 tons in the Great Lakes area.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of shipping during October were: Montreal, 2,255,641 tons (1,678,238 tons in October, 1957); Seven Islands, 1,612,677 (2,111,702); Vancouver, 1,052,148 (837,115); Port Arthur, 952,059 (978,879); and Toronto, 665,356 (546,443).
