The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports in the month of November rose 7.4 per cent to 15,422,456 tons from 14,364,106 in November, 1957. The rise was chiefly attributable to increased coastal trade with loadings up 18.1 per cent to 4,076,191 tons from 3,453,065 and unloadings up 10.5 per cent to 4,000,875 tons from 3,619,840. In foreign trade, unloadings rose 6.5 per cent to 3,430,809 tons from 3,221,704, but loadings were down by 3.6 per cent to 3,914,581 tons from 4,061,497. For the period January to November, cargoes handled at Canadian ports amounted to 134,574,850 tons, 10.2 per cent below last year. This decrease was wholly due to a drop in foreign trade which fell 19.5 per cent to 67,527,318 tons from 83,924,489. Coastwise shipments at 67,047,532 tons were up by 1.7 per cent. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services decreased to 22,515 from 24,178 in November, 1957, while registered net tonnage rose to 27,371,603 tons from 23,631,954. For the period January-November, arrivals and departures decreased by 15,287.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with November, 1957, loadings of gypsum were up by 157,750 tons, sand, gravel and crushed stone by 45,929 tons, and newsprint by 32,770 tons. These increases were offset by decreases in iron ore and wheat of 134,439 and 125,761 tons, respectively. Decreases were also recorded in shipments of oats, pulpwood and general cargo, resulting in an overall decrease of 154,916 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign ports increased by 209,105 tons. The largest increases were in bituminous coal, up by 94,712 tons, and in iron ore, up by 68,472 tons.

In coastal trade increased unloadings of wheat, pulpwood and barley offset decreases in petroleum products, gasoline, sand, gravel, and crushed stone, resulting in an overall increase of 381,035 tons.

Loadings were up 3.2 per cent to 3,439,791 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, and up 14.0 per cent to 3,189,865 tons in the Great Lakes area, while on the Pacific coast they were down 2.1 per cent to 1,361,116 tons. Unloadings were up in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region unloadings were up 6.6 per cent to 3,173,697 tons, in the Great Lakes area 11.3 per cent to 3,535,398 tons and on the Pacific coast 4.9 per cent to 722,589 tons.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo during November were: Montreal, 2,622,199 tons (2,247,064 tons in November, 1957); Port Arthur, 1,139,646 (839,755); Vancouver, 882,893 (1,032,456); and Prescott, 656,818 (442,422).
