SHIPPING STATISTICS

April 1958

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during April totalled 8,752,621 tons, 19.6 per cent below the 10,890,074 tons reported for April last year. Cargos loaded in foreign trade declined by 16 per cent to 2,121,690 tons from 2,535,917 while unloadings fell 44 per cent, dropping to 1,750,955 tons from 3,107,078. In coastal trade, loadings declined to 2,675,827 tons from 2,736,645 and unloadings to 2,204,149 tons from 2,510,434. For the period January-April, cargoes handled at Canadian ports were 14.3 per cent below last year, dropping to 18,740,908 tons from 21,879,476. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade decreased to 10,249,130 tons from 12,654,383 and in coastal trade to 8,491,778 tons from 9,225,093. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services rose to 19,048 from 18,393 in April, 1957, while registered net tonnage dropped to 18,626,508 from 19,349,123. For the period January-April the number of arrivals and departures decreased by 2,591.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were wheat, newsprint, gypsum and lumber. Compared with April 1957, loadings of wheat were up by 281,505 tons while woodpulp and lumber recorded smaller increases, 54,958 and 47,799 tons respectively. These increases, however, were more than offset by decreases in iron ore of 216,442 tons, gypsum 128,398 tons and crude petroleum 114,500 tons. Loadings of petroleum oils and general cargo also declined and the total was down by 414,227 tons. Cargo unloaded from foreign ports recorded a decline of 1,356,123 tons. This was largely due to a drop of more than 1.2 million tons in bituminous coal.

In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, barley, gasoline and pulpwood. Although unloadings of barley, pulpwood and bituminous coal were higher than in the previous April, sizeable decreases in wheat, iron ore, petroleum products, and general cargo resulted in an overall decline this April of 306,285 tons.

Loadings were down 18.7 per cent to 1,660,009 tons at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports but up 6.1 per cent to 1,437,014 tons at Pacific Coast ports. In contrast, unloadings rose 5.3 per cent to 1,506,881 tons in the Atlantic region but dropped 25.5 per cent to 664,789 tons on the Pacific coast. On the Great Lakes, loadings declined 9.3 per cent to 1,700,494 tons while unloadings, at 1,783,434 tons were off 45.8 per cent from the previous year.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of shipping during April were as follows (data for the corresponding month last year in brackets): Montreal, 1,059,398 tons (884,743); Vancouver, 1,045,673 tons (961,135); Port Arthur, 628,104 tons (667,432) and Hamilton, 539,919 tons (804,098).
