



SHIPPING STATISTICS

May, 1958

The total volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during May amounted to 17,596,710 tons, a decrease of 1,818,944 tons or 9.3 per cent from the May 1957 total of 19,415,654 tons. In foreign trade loadings were down 17.3 per cent to 4,446,-085 tons and unloadings 38.6 per cent to 3,122,918 tons. In coastal trade loadings rose 11.4 per cent to 4,837,669 tons and unloadings 12.6 per cent to 5,190,038 tons. For the period January-May, cargoes handled at Canadian ports were 12.0 per cent below last year, dropping to 36,337,618 tons from 41,295,130. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade decreased to 17,818,133 tons from 23,122,431 while freight handled in coastal trade increased slightly to 18,519,485 tons from 18,172,699. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services totalled 25,712 as against 26,957 in May 1957 while registered net tonnage dropped to 27,982,284 tons from 30,604,219. For the period January-May the number of arrivals and departures decreased by 1,629.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were iron ore, wheat, barley and newsprint. Compared with May 1957, loadings of wheat were up by 486,927 tons and barley up 191,211 tons while lumber and woodpulp recorded smaller increases, 31,808 and 27,467 tons respectively. These increases, however, were more than offset by a decrease in iron ore of 1,153,834 tons. Other decreases were recorded in shipments of crude petroleum, gypsum and pulpwood resulting in a net decline of 933,094 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign ports recorded a decline of 1,965,951 tons. This was largely due to a drop of more than 1.2 million tons in bituminous coal.

In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, barley and pulpwood. Although unloadings were down from the previous year for some commodities an increase of 609,171 tons of wheat, 243,026 tons of barley, 202,263 tons of pulpwood plus other minor increases resulted in an overall increase of 582,853.

Loadings were down 9.4 per cent to 4,171,634 tons at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River ports and down 19.5 per cent to 1,472,446 tons on the Pacific coast while on the Great Lakes they were up 10.8 per cent to 3,639,674 tons. Unloadings were down in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence region cargoes unloaded dropped 6.2 per cent to 3,330,364 tons, in the Great Lakes area 19.9 per cent to 4,188,706 tons and on the Pacific coast 13.2 per cent to 792,086 tons.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of shipping during May were: Montreal, 2,607,651 tons (1,810,113 in May, 1957); Port Arthur, 1,283,755 (1,575,139); Vancouver, 1,117,619 (1,438,445); and Seven Islands, 863,473 (1,610,-588).
