SHIPPING STATISTICS

July, 1958

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during July totalled 17,479,030 tons, 14.8 per cent below the 20,513,335 tons reported for July last year. Cargoes loaded in foreign trade declined 32 per cent to 4,381,725 tons while unloadings fell 24 per cent to 3,839,715 tons. In coastal trade, loadings rose to 4,265,456 tons from 4,109,806 and unloadings to 4,992,134 tons from 4,939,489. For the period January-July, cargoes handled at Canadian ports were 12.7 per cent below last year, dropping to 71,131,306 tons from 81,526,535. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade decreased to 34,240,032 tons from 45,692,303 while freight handled in coastal trade increased to 36,891,274 tons from 35,834,232. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services totalled 27,102 as against 31,388 in July, 1957, while registered net tonnage dropped to 27,380,616 tons from 32,916,939. For the period January-July the number of arrivals and departures decreased by 12,370 to 131,759.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were wheat, iron ore, lumber and newsprint. Compared with July, 1957 loadings of lumber were up by 72,113 tons, sand, gravel and crushed stone by 40,681 tons, woodpulp by 39,937 tons and wheat by 39,889 tons. These increases were more than offset by a decrease of 1,540,583 tons in iron ore and smaller decreases in gypsum, pulpwood and general cargo, the net decrease for the month amounting to 2,044,675 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign ports were down by 1,197,925 tons. The largest decreases were in bituminous coal which dropped to 1,066,406 tons from 1,848,558 and in iron ore down to 795,761 tons from 954,792.

In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, petroleum products and iron ore. Although unloadings of many commodities including iron ore and sand, gravel and crushed stone were lower than in the previous July increases in wheat, oats, barley and gasoline resulted in an overall increase this July of 52,645 tons.

Loadings were down 26.5 per cent to 4,554,470 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, 5.1 per cent to 2,759,323 tons in the Great Lakes area and 6.6 per cent to 1,333,288 on the Pacific Coast. Unloadings fell 14.4 per cent to 3,756,994 tons at Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence river ports and 12.0 per cent to 4,322,195 on the Great Lakes but rose 10.7 per cent to 752,660 tons on the Pacific Coast.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of shipping during July were: Montreal, 2,087,001 tons (2,392,861 tons in July 1957); Seven Islands, 1,658,865 (2,626,119); Hamilton, 985,304 (1,113,379); and Port Arthur, 919,313 (1,149,046).
