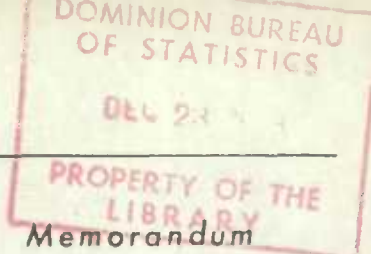

SHIPPING STATISTICS

September, 1958

The total volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during September amounted to 15,078,079 tons, 14.0 per cent below the September 1957 total of 17,529,533 tons. In foreign trade loadings were down 30.1 per cent to 3,965,445 tons and unloadings 13.0 per cent to 4,041,817 tons. In coastal trade loadings increased 5.3 per cent to 3,478,399 tons, while unloadings decreased 8.1 per cent to 3,592,418 tons. For the period January-September cargoes handled at Canadian ports were 13.6 per cent below last year, dropping to 102,073,705 tons from 118,139,058. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade decreased to 51,206,320 tons from 67,054,410 and in coastal trade to 50,867,385 tons from 51,084,648. Vessel arrivals and departures in both foreign and coastwise service increased to 25,832 from 25,413 in September 1957, although the registered net tonnage decreased to 27,809,642 from 28,491,880. For the period January-September the number of arrivals and departures decreased by 13,624.

Commodities loaded in foreign trade fell by 1,704,410 tons, largely as a result of a decrease of 1,024,875 tons in shipments of iron ore. Other decreases were recorded in wheat, lumber, pulpwood and gypsum. Compared with September 1957 loadings of sand, gravel and crushed stone were up by 63,888 tons, woodpulp by 26,817 tons and newsprint by 17,847 tons. Cargoes loaded in greatest volume during the month were iron ore, wheat, gypsum and newsprint. Unloadings from foreign ports fell by 603,383 tons. The largest decreases were in bituminous coal which dropped to 1,660,655 tons from 1,809,130, iron ore down to 600,066 tons from 735,563 and in crude petroleum down to 348,710 tons from 382,613.

In coastal trade the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum products, pulpwood and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of barley, wheat, bituminous coal and pulpwood were higher than in the previous year, decreases in iron ore and sand, gravel and crushed stone resulted in an overall decline this September of 317,439 tons.

Loadings were down 19.5 per cent to 4,480,586 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, and down 33.0 per cent to 896,992 tons on the Pacific coast while in the Great Lakes area they showed little change at 2,066,266 tons. Unloadings were also down in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence region cargoes unloaded dropped 10.3 per cent to 3,282,646 tons, in the Great Lakes area 11.3 per cent to 3,686,925 tons and on the Pacific coast 10.1 per cent to 664,664 tons.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of shipping during September were: Montreal, 1,949,804 tons (1,979,635 tons in September 1957); Seven Islands, 1,406,642 (2,328,249); Hamilton, 849,108 (993,905); Port Arthur, 682,146 (772,956); and Vancouver, 594,123 (991,761).
