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SHIPPING STATISTICS

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The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during October rose 20.4 per cent to 20,569,492 tons from 17,078,689 in October 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 19.8 per cent to 5,998,059 tons from 5,005,648 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 2.8 per cent to 4,082,726 tons from 3,969,960. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 30.6 per cent to 5,249,095 tons from 4,017,930, while unloadings, were up by 28.3 per cent to 5,239,612 tons from 4,085,151. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 31,439 from 24,730 with registered net tonnage up 20.4 per cent to 34,697,158 tons from 28,827,007.

For the period January-October, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 15.6 per cent to 138,014,387 tons from 119,412,785 in the corresponding period last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 18.7 per cent to 72,126,853 tons from 60,785,198 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 12.4 per cent to 65,887,534 tons from 58,627,587. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services numbered 241,079 as against 212,786 in the corresponding period last year while registered net tonnage rose to 246,091,027 tons from 216,307,820.

During October, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum and newsprint. Compared with October, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 913,899 tons and gypsum by 154,179 tons with total loadings recording an increase of 992,411 tons. Foreign unloadings were down for some commodities, a major decrease being iron ore which dropped to 148,451 tons from 446,-867. Increases in other commodities, however, including petroleum oils, up 224,725 tons, bituminous coal, 138,511 tons, and sand, gravel and crushed stone, up 87,595 tons, resulted in an overall increase this October to 112,766 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in pulpwood, iron ore, petroleum oils, wheat and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of wheat, oats and barley were lower than in October, 1958, increases in iron ore, pulpwood and petroleum oils resulted in an overall increase of 1,154,461 tons.

Shipping reports for October showed increased activity in all areas. Cargoes loaded in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were up 32.7 per cent to 6,255,016 tons, in the Great Lakes area, 14.8 per cent to 3,320,800 tons, and on the Pacific coast 17.9 per cent to 1,671,338 tons. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes unloaded rose 27.1 per cent to 4,380,633 tons, in the Great Lakes area 1.8 per cent to 3,892,225 tons and on the Pacific coast 33.9 per cent to 1,049,480 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during October were: Montreal, 2,513,470 tons (2,555,641 tons in October, 1958); Seven Islands, 2,375,124 tons (1,612,677); Port Arthur, 1,246,111 tons (952,059); Vancouver, 1,005,888 tons (1,052,148); and Hamilton, 956,386 tons (624,248).
