



SHIPPING STATISTICS

November, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports in the month of November increased 12.2 per cent to 17,301,039 tons from 15,422,456 in November, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries rose 26.7 per cent to 4,961,486 tons from 3,914,581 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 15.9 per cent to 3,977,415 tons from 3,430,809. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 1.6 per cent to 4,142,158 tons from 4,076,191, while unloadings were up 5.5 per cent to 4,219,980 tons from 4,000,875. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased this month to 24,890 from 22,515 and the registered net tonnage rose 12.1 per cent to 30,690,646 tons from 27,371,603.

For the period January-November, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 13.4 per cent to 276,781,673 tons from 244,090,676 a year earlier. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries rose 20.0 per cent to 81,065,754 tons from 67,527,318 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping increased 10.7 per cent to 74,249,672 tons from 67,047,532. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services rose in total to 265,969 from 234,902 last year while registered net tonnage increased to 276,781,673 tons from 244,090,676.

During November, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum and newsprint. Compared with November, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 948,757 tons and wheat by 103,723 tons with total loadings recording an increase of 1,046,905 tons. Unloadings from foreign countries were up by 546,606 tons. Increases in petroleum oils of 327,241 tons, iron ore of 195,006 tons and crude petroleum, 180,906 tons, more than offset decreases in other commodities.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils, pulpwood, gasoline and iron ore. Although unloadings of wheat, barley and oats were lower than in November, 1958, increases in iron ore and pulpwood resulted in an overall increase of 219,105 tons.

Loadings were up 37.3 per cent to 4,724,316 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region and up 11.0 per cent to 1,510,425 tons on the Pacific coast, while in the Great Lakes area they were down 10.1 per cent to 2,868,903 tons. Unloadings showed an increase of 26.6 per cent to 4,016,853 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region and 18.3 per cent to 854,747 tons on the Pacific coast but a drop of 5.9 per cent to 3,325,795 tons in the Great Lakes area.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during November were: Montreal, 2,466,736 tons (2,622,199 tons in November, 1958); Seven Islands, 1,379,461 tons (551,977); Vancouver, 928,981 tons (882,893); Port Arthur, 911,756 tons (1,139,646); and Hamilton, 724,197 tons (430,317).
