December, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during December increased 31.0 per cent to 10,546,809 tons from 8,049,540 in December, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries rose 10.2 per cent to 2,633,282 tons from 2,390,630 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 9.5 per cent to 1,653,219 tons from 1,510,149. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 77.4 per cent to 3,160,975 tons from 1,781,523, while unloadings were up 30.9 per cent to 3,099,333 tons from 2,367,238. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased this month to 22,213 from 16,693 and the registered net tonnage rose 19.6 per cent to 21,087,855 tons from 17,633,129.

During the year 1959 a total of 165,862,235 tons of cargo was handled at Canadian ports. This was 11.6 per cent above the previous year's total of 148,581,021 tons. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries rose 19.5 per cent to 85,352,255 tons from 71,432,576 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping aggregated 80,509,980 tons, an increase of 4.4 per cent over the 77,148,445 tons recorded in 1958. Total arrivals and departures in both services increased to 288,182 from 262,453 last year while registered net tonnage rose to 297,869,528 from 268,025,667.

During December, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were wheat, iron ore, gypsum and lumber. Compared with December, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 126,394 tons, wheat by 55,142 tons and general by 37,165 tons with total loadings recording an increase of 242,652 tons. Unloadings from foreign countries were up by 143,070 tons. Decreases in bituminous coal and petroleum oils of 109,647 and 52,108 tons, respectively, were more than offset by increases in iron ore and other commodities.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils, sand, gravel and crushed stone, pulpwood and logs. Although unloadings of barley and cement were lower than in December, 1958, increases in sand, gravel and crushed stone, petroleum oils, pulpwood and iron ore resulted in an overall increase of 732,095 tons.

Shipping reports for December showed increased activity in all areas. Cargoes loaded in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were up 54.6 per cent to 2,465,150 tons, in the Great Lakes Area, 32.0 per cent to 1,539,772 tons, and on the Pacific coast 26.8 per cent to 1,789,335 tons. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes unloaded rose 25.7 per cent to 1,890,981 tons, in the Great Lakes area 12.3 per cent to 1,916,858 tons and on the Pacific coast 49.4 per cent to 944,713 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during December were: Montreal, 956,949 tons (643,947 tons in December, 1958); Vancouver 944,497 tons (995,843); Halifax, 654,418 tons (748,279); and Port Arthur, 596,686 tons (431,601).

The figures quoted for the year 1959 are subject to revision in the annual "Shipping Report".
