SHIPPING STATISTICS

April, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during April totalled 8,612,513 tons, 1.6 per cent below the 8,752,621 tons reported for April last year. In foreign trade, loadings increased 29.3 per cent to 2,743,744 tons from 2,121,690, while unloadings rose 8.9 per cent to 1,906,713 tons from 1,750,955. In coastal trade, loadings declined by 18.6 per cent to 2,177,978 tons from 2,675,827 and unloadings fell 19.1 per cent to 1,784,078 tons from 2,204,149. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services decreased to 17,696 from 19,048 in April, 1958 with registered net tonnage down to 18,388,112 tons from 18,626,508.

For the period January-April cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 10.2 per cent to 20,646,658 tons from 18,740,908 in the same period last year. Loadings and unloadings in foreign trade increased 19.1 per cent to 12,210,285 tons from 10,249,130 while cargoes handled in coastal trade showed a slight decrease of 0.7 per cent to 8,436,373 tons from 8,491,778. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 54,731 from 52,950.

During April commodities loaded in greatest volume in foreign trade were wheat, iron ore, gypsum, lumber and newsprint. Compared with April, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 374,979 tons, gypsum by 183,056 tons, barley by 57,607 tons and lumber by 49,827 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 622,054 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign ports were up by 155,758 tons. The largest increases were in crude petroleum, up by 70,863 tons, sand, gravel and crushed stone, by 60,710 tons and bituminous coal, by 54,854 tons.

In coastal trade, the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils, logs and sand, gravel and crushed stone. Although unloadings of logs, pulpwood, and sand, gravel and crushed stone were higher than in the previous year, large decreases in wheat, barley and gasoline resulted in an overall decline this April of 420,071 tons.

Loadings were up 22.7 per cent to 2,036,033 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River Region and up 16.8 per cent to 1,677,946 tons on the Pacific coast while unloadings were down by 8.0 per cent to 1,385,620 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence region but up 30.1 per cent to 865,015 tons on the Pacific coast. With navigation opening some ten days later than in 1958 loadings in the Great Lakes area were down 29.0 per cent to 1,209,743 tons and unloadings were down 19.2 per cent to 1,440,156 tons.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo during April were: Vancouver, 1,074,377 tons (1,045,673 in April, 1958); Montreal, 693,721 tons (1,059,398); and Halifax, 583,467 tons (439,169).
