SHIPPING STATISTICS

May, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of May rose 2.0 per cent to 17,956,698 tons from 17,596,710 in May, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 23.9 per cent to 5,506,689 tons from 4,446,085 and cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 22.3 per cent to 3,820,561 tons from 3,122,918. In coastwise service, loadings decreased 11.2 per cent to 4,294,933 tons from 4,837,669, while unloadings declined 16.5 per cent to 4,334,525 tons from 5,190,038.

For the period January-May, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 16.2 per cent to 38,603,356 tons from 36,337,618 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 23.2 per cent to 9,327,250 tons from 7,569,003. The volume of freight handled in coastwise service decreased 13.9 per cent to 8,629,448 tons from 10,027,707. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 28,875 from 25,712 in May, 1958, with registered net tonnage up to 30,807,017 tons from 27,982,284.

During May, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with May, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 1,158,626 tons, gypsum by 231,220 tons and sand, gravel and crushed stone by 61,094 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 1,060,604 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 697,643 tons. The largest increases were in iron ore, up by 230,077 tons, bituminous coal, by 146,598 tons, sand, gravel and crushed stone, by 37,222 tons and crude petroleum by 28,245 tons.

In coastwise service the greatest volume of shipping was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils, pulpwood, gasoline and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of iron ore, bituminous coal and logs were higher than in the previous year, large decreases in wheat, barley and pulpwood resulted in an overall decline this May of 855,513 tons.

Loadings were up 11.0 per cent to 4,631,977 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region and up 23.1 per cent to 1,812,483 tons on the Pacific coast, while in the Great Lakes area they were down 7.8 per cent to 3,357,152 tons. Unloadings showed an increase of 1.2 per cent to 3,369,787 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region and 27.0 per cent to 1,007,952 tons on the Pacific coast but a drop of 9.8 per cent to 3,777,347 tons in the Great Lakes area.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during May were: Montreal, 2,183,730 tons (2,607,651 tons in May, 1958); Seven Islands, 1,706,412 tons (863,473); Port Arthur, 1,256,351 tons (1,283,755); Vancouver, 1,190,488 tons (1,117,619) and Hamilton, 804,413 tons (638,634).
