SHIPPING STATISTICS

June, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of June rose 11.5 per cent to 19,297,403 tons from 17,314,658 in June, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 30.1 per cent to 6,036,033 tons from 4,640,402 and cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 10.9 per cent to 3,947,122 tons from 3,560,057. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 5.1 per cent to 4,537,904 tons from 4,319,753, while unloadings showed a slight decline to 4,776,344 tons from 4,794,446. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 32,146 from 26,979 with registered net tonnage up to 34,028,397 tons from 26,898,732.

For the period January-June, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 7.9 per cent to 57,900,759 tons from 53,652,276 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 21.1 per cent to 31,520,690 tons from 26,018,592 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping dropped 4.5 per cent to 26,380,069 tons from 27,633,684. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 110,585 from 105,641, with registered net tonnage up to 117,103,768 tons from 102,377,217.

During June, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, lumber and newsprint. Compared with June, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 690,126 tons, gypsum by 277,883 tons and wheat by 66,181 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 1,395,631 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 387,065 tons. The largest increases were in iron ore, up by 354,337 tons, limestone, by 90,624 tons, sand, gravel and crushed stone by 67,048 tons and general cargo by 56,079 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, petroleum oils, bituminous coal and iron ore. Although unloadings of iron ore, logs, and bituminous coal were higher than in the previous year, large decreases in barley, wheat, general cargo and pulpwood resulted in an overall decline this June of 18,102 tons.

Loadings were up in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes loaded rose 22.1 per cent to 5,704,801 tons, in the Great Lakes area 5.1 per cent to 2,998,789 tons and on the Pacific coast 30.5 per cent to 1,870,347 tons. Unloadings showed an increase of 5.9 per cent to 3,660,338 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, a decrease of 1.1 per cent to 4,035,439 tons in the Great Lakes area and an increase of 26 per cent to 1,027,689 tons on the Pacific coast.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during June were: Montreal, 2,230,137 tons (2,041,546 tons in June, 1958); Seven Islands, 2,069,294 tons (1,577,602); Vancouver, 1,203,164 tons (1,019,705); Port Arthur, 1,157,687 tons (1,008,931) and Hamilton, 923,814 tons (941,147).

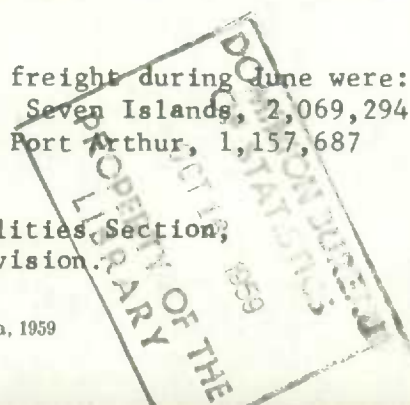
