SHIPPING STATISTICS

July, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of July rose 17.9 per cent to 20,612,934 tons from 17,479,030 in July, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 25.2 per cent to 5,485,171 tons from 4,381,725 and cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 27.0 per cent to 4,874,535 tons from 3,839,715. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 22.8 per cent to 5,238,398 tons from 4,265,456, while unloadings increased to 5,014,830 tons from 4,992,134. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 33,277 from 27,102 with registered net tonnage up to 36,068,778 tons from 27,380,616.

For the period January-July, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 10.4 per cent to 78,513,693 tons from 71,131,306 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 22.3 per cent to 41,880,396 tons from 34,240,032 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping dropped slightly to 36,633,297 tons from 36,891,274. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 149,029 from 132,827, with registered net tonnage up to 144,484,384 tons from 129,937,209.

During July, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and general. Compared with July, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 384,618 tons, gypsum by 321,087 tons and general by 50,269 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 1,103,446 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 1,034,820 tons. The largest increases were in bituminous coal, up by 443,809 tons, petroleum oils, by 207,051 tons, limestone, by 121,764 tons and general cargo by 61,298 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, petroleum oils, iron ore and gasoline. Although unloadings of barley, oats and iron ore were lower than in July, 1958, increases in petroleum oils, wheat, sand, gravel and crushed stone, and pulpwood resulted in an overall increase of 22,696 tons.

Loadings were up in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes loaded rose 28.9 per cent to 5,869,783 tons, in the Great Lakes area 24.3 per cent to 3,429,404 tons and on the Pacific coast 6.8 per cent to 1,424,382 tons. Unloadings showed an increase of 12.2 per cent to 4,214,970 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, an increase of 12.8 per cent to 4,876,781 tons in the Great Lakes area and an increase of 6.0 per cent to 797,614 tons on the Pacific coast.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during July were: Montreal, 2,567,193 tons (2,087,001 tons in July, 1958); Seven Islands, 1,836,133 tons (1,658,865); Port Arthur, 1,430,776 tons (919,313); Hamilton, 1,174,358 tons (985,304); Sault Ste. Marie, 900,286 tons (504,409); and Vancouver, 900,028 tons (896,386).
