



SHIPPING STATISTICS

August, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of August rose 20.1 per cent to 19,060,133 tons from 15,864,320 in August, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 24.0 per cent to 5,553,344 tons from 4,477,548 and cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 3.0 per cent to 4,616,327 tons from 4,481,478. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 34.4 per cent to 4,327,476 tons from 3,220,124, while unloadings increased to 4,562,986 tons from 3,685,170. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 30,959 from 28,998 with registered net tonnage up to 33,430,477 tons from 30,145,215.

For the period January-August, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 12.2 per cent to 97,573,826 tons from 86,995,626 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 20.5 per cent to 52,050,067 tons from 43,199,058 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 3.9 per cent to 45,523,759 tons from 43,796,568. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 179,988 from 161,825, with registered net tonnage up to 177,914,861 tons from 160,082,424.

During August, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and general. Compared with August, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 926,444 tons, gypsum by 245,578 tons and limestone by 61,091 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 1,075,796 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 134,849 tons. The largest increases were in petroleum oils, up by 236,213 tons, bituminous coal, by 218,723 tons, and limestone, by 67,344 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, pulpwood, iron ore, petroleum oils and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of logs and barley were lower than in August, 1958, increases in iron ore, wheat, sand, gravel and crushed stone and petroleum oils resulted in an overall increase of 877,816 tons.

Loadings were up 39.6 per cent to 6,252,229 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, down 17.1 per cent to 998,742 tons on the Pacific coast and up 30.7 per cent to 2,629,849 tons in the Great Lakes area. Unloadings showed an increase of 14.2 per cent to 4,044,895 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, a drop of 10.4 per cent to 654,137 tons on the Pacific coast and an increase of 15.0 per cent to 4,480,281 tons in the Great Lakes area.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during August were: Seven Islands, 2,598,441 tons (1,489,549 tons in August, 1958); Montreal, 2,252,362 tons (2,160,820); Hamilton, 1,164,935 tons (1,026,280); Port Arthur, 1,071,691 tons (478,705); and Vancouver, 680,291 tons (959,952).
