## SHIPPING STATISTICS September, 1959

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of September rose 31.8 per cent to 19,871,069 tons from 15,078,079 in September, 1958. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 47.4 per cent to 5,844,206 tons from 3,965,445 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose only 2.7 per cent to 4,151,795 tons from 4,041,817. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 50.0 per cent to 5,218,411 tons from 3,478,399, while unloadings, were up by 29.6 per cent to 4,656,657 tons from 3,592,418. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 29,652 from 25,832 with registered net tonnage up to 33,479,008 tons from 27,809,642.

For the period January-September, 1959, cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 15.1 per cent to 117,444,895 tons from 102,073,705 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 21.2 per cent to 62,046,068 tons from 51,206,320 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 8.9 per cent to 55,398,827 tons from 50,867,385. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services numbered 209,640 as against 187,657 in the corresponding period last year while registered net tonnage rose to 211,393,- 869 tons from 187,892,066.

During September, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and pulpwood. Compared with September, 1958, loadings of iron ore were up by 1,199,974 tons, gypsum by 261,640 tons and wheat by 206,687 tons, with total loadings recording an increase of 1,878,761 tons. Although foreign unloadings were down for some commodities, increases in petroleum oils of 269,510 tons, crude petroleum, 207,125 tons, and general cargo, 49,109 tons, resulted in an overall increase this September of 109,978 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in iron ore, wheat, pulpwood, petroleum oils and bituminous coal. Although unloadings of barley and general cargo were lower than in September, 1958, increases in iron ore, wheat, sand, gravel and crushed stone, and petroleum oils resulted in an overall increase of 1,064,239 tons.

Loadings were up in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes loaded rose 57.4 per cent to 7,053,280 tons, in the Great Lakes area, 33.2 per cent to 2,752,172 tons, and on the Pacific coast 40.2 per cent to 1,257,165 tons. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes unloaded rose 24.7 per cent to 4,094,626 tons, in the Great Lakes area 8.1 per cent to 3,985,562 tons and on the Pacific coast 9.6 per cent to 728,264 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during September were: Seven Islands, 2,734,220 tons (1,406,642 tons in September, 1958); Montreal, 2,067,993 tons (1,949,804); Hamilton, 1,069,300 tons (849,108); Port Arthur, 1,062,706 tons (682,146); and Vancouver, 828,254 tons (594,123).
