Freight handled at Canadian ports during October declined 3.5 per cent to 19,851,074 tons from 20,569,492 tons in October, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries decreased 8.7 per cent to 5,477,008 tons from 5,998,059 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries rose 21.7 per cent to 4,967,375 tons from 4,082,726. In coastwise shipping, loadings were down 6.7 per cent to 4,895,725 tons from 5,249,-095 while unloadings decreased 13.9 per cent to 4,510,966 tons from 5,239,612. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 33,801 from 31,439 with registered net tonnage up to 35,594,143 tons from 34,697,158.

For the period January-October, 1960, the volume of freight handled at Canadian ports rose 5.1 per cent to 145,060,465 tons from 138,014,387 in the same period last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 7.9 per cent to 77,838,931 tons from 72,126,853 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 2.0 per cent to 67,221,534 tons from 65,887,534. Arrivals and departures in both services rose to 256,072 from 241,079 while the registered net tonnage increased 11.7 per cent to 274,796,718 tons from 246,091,027.

Commodities loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with October, 1959, loadings were down by 521,051 tons due largely to a drop of 906,915 tons in iron ore. Unloadings from foreign countries were up by 884,649 tons. Increases in crude petroleum and iron ore of 522,460 and 401,727 tons, respectively, more than offset decreases in other commodities.

The greatest volume of coastwise shipping was recorded in pulpwood, petroleum oils and wheat. Although unloadings of some commodities, including sand, gravel and crushed stone were slightly higher than in October, 1959, a decrease in iron ore of 522,253 tons along with smaller decreases in other commodities resulted in an overall decrease of 728,646 tons.

Loading in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were down 7.1 per cent to 5,809,005 tons and in the Great Lakes area 18.1 per cent to 2,719,534 tons. On the Pacific coast, however, loadings rose 10.3 per cent to 1,844,194 tons. Unloadings were up in all three areas. In the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region cargoes unloaded rose 0.9 per cent to 4,421,400 tons, in the Great Lakes area 0.7 per cent to 3,918,302 tons and on the Pacific coast 8.5 per cent to 1,138,639 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during October were: Montreal, 2,744,318 tons (2,513,470 tons in October, 1959); Seven Islands, 1,609,416 tons (2,375,124); Vancouver, 1,047,287 tons (1,005,888); Hamilton, 1,003,054 tons (956,386); and Port Arthur, 948,227 tons (1,246,111).
