SHIPPING STATISTICS

November, 1960

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during the month of November decreased 4.9 per cent to 16,448,675 tons from 17,301,039 in November, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries were down 24.4 per cent to 3,750,242 tons from 4,961,486 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries decreased 2.0 per cent to 3,898,748 tons from 3,977,415. In coastwise shipping, loadings were up 7.8 per cent to 4,467,193 tons from 4,142,158 while unloadings increased 2.7 per cent to 4,332,492 tons from 4,219,980. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 26,591 from 24,890 but registered net tonnage declined to 30,364,226 tons from 30,690,646.

For the period January-November, 1960, the volume of freight handled at Canadian ports rose 4.0 per cent to 161,509,140 tons from 155,315,426 in the same period last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 5.5 per cent to 85,487,921 tons from 81,065,754 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 2.4 per cent to 76,021,219 tons from 74,249,672. Arrivals and departures in both services rose to 282,663 from 265,969 while the registered net tonnage increased 10.3 per cent to 305,160,944 tons from 276,781,673.

During November, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were wheat, iron ore, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with November, 1959, loadings of iron ore were down by 1,380,288 tons. Grain shipments also declined, offsetting minor increases in pulpwood, gypsum and lumber and resulting in an overall decrease of 1,211,244 tons. Unloadings from foreign countries were down by 78,667 tons. Increases in crude petroleum and bauxite of 246,321 and 66,489 tons, respectively, were more than offset by decreases in petroleum oils, down by 261,176 tons, bituminous coal, by 204,101 tons and iron ore, by 200,222 tons.

In coastwise shipping, the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils and pulpwood. Although unloadings of iron ore and bituminous coal were down compared with November, 1959, increased shipments of petroleum oils, wheat and other commodities resulted in an overall increase of 112,512 tons.

Loadings in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were down 17.4 per cent to 3,901,199 tons and in the Great Lakes area 11.4 per cent to 2,542,265 tons. On the Pacific coast, however, loadings rose 17.4 per cent to 1,773,971 tons. Unloadings in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region increased 7.6 per cent to 4,322,107 tons but in the Great Lakes area they dropped 11.3 per cent to 2,951,663 tons. On the Pacific coast unloadings were up 12.0 per cent to 957,470 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during November were: Montreal, 2,810,850 tons (2,466,736 tons in November, 1959); Vancouver, 940,957 tons (928,981); Port Arthur, 800,435 tons (911,756); Toronto, 702,322 tons (599,682); and Halifax, 587,866 tons (295,991).
