## SHIPPING STATISTICS

April, 1960

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during April increased 29.4 per cent to 11,143,394 tons from 8,612,513 in April, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries decreased 10.0 per cent to 2,470,368 tons from 2,743,744 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries increased 51.9 per cent to 2,896,235 tons from 1,906,713. In coastwise shipping, loadings rose 32.5 per cent to 2,885,996 tons from 2,177,978, while unloadings were up 62.0 per cent to 2,890,795 tons from 1,784,078. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased this month to 19,741 from 17,696 and the registered net tonnage rose 21.6 per cent to 22,351,375 tons from 18,388,112.

For the period January - April cargoes handled at Canadian ports increased 21.1 per cent to 25,005,741 tons from 20,646,658 in the same period last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries rose 9.6 per cent to 13,384,526 tons from 12,210,285 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping aggregated 11,621,215 tons, an increase of 37.8 per cent over the 8,436,373 tons recorded in April, 1959. Total arrivals and departures in both services increased to 62,811 from 54,731 last year while registered net tonnage rose 17.0 per cent to 61,139,284 tons from 52,268,354.

During April, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were wheat, iron ore, lumber, newsprint and gypsum. Compared with April, 1959, total loadings were down by 273,376 tons due largely to decreased shipments of iron ore, wheat and gypsum. Unloadings from foreign countries were up by 989,522 tons. Increases in bituminous coal of 395,583 tons, iron ore of 215,852 tons and bauxite, 169,969 tons, more than offset decreases in other commodities.

In coastwise shipping all commodities except sand, gravel and cement recorded increases. Total unloadings were up by 1,106,717 tons, the major increases being in wheat, up 445,584 tons, pulpwood, 200,603 tons, petroleum oils and gasoline, 142,109 tons, and logs, 112,383 tons.

Shipping reports for April showed increased activity on the Atlantic coast and Great Lakes with a slight decline on the Pacific coast. Cargoes loaded in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence Region were up 1.3 per cent to 2,061,889 tons but on the Pacific coast loadings were down by 12.3 per cent to 1,471,289 tons. Unloadings, however, increased 46.9 per cent to 2,100,956 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence and 21.1 per cent to 1,047,266 tons on the Pacific coast. With navigation opening one week earlier than in 1959, loadings in the Great Lakes area increased 51.0 per cent to 1,823,186 tons while unloadings rose 83.2 per cent to 2,638,808 tons.

Canadian ports registering the greatest volume of cargo during April were: Vancouver, 1,028,497 tons (1,074,377 in April, 1959); Montreal, 1,002,772 tons (693,721); Hamilton, 901,328 tons (405,213); Port Arthur, 733,660 tons (397,871); and Halifax, 583,730 tons (583,467).
