



SHIPPING STATISTICS

May, 1960

The volume of freight handled at Canadian ports during May rose 9.0 per cent to 19,569,531 tons from 17,956,698 in May, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 3.5 per cent to 5,698,370 tons from 5,506,689 while cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up 26.6 per cent to 4,835,485 tons from 3,820-561. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 1.4 per cent to 4,356,211 tons from 4,294,923, while unloadings were up 8.0 per cent to 4,679,465 tons from 4,334,525. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased this month to 29,998 from 28,875 and the registered net tonnage rose 8.5 per cent to 33,419,057 tons from 30,807,017.

For the period January-May, 1960, cargoes handled at Canadian ports were up 15.5 per cent to 44,575,272 tons from 38,603,356 one year earlier. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries rose 11.1 per cent to 23,918,381 tons from 21,537,535 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping totalled 20,656,891 tons, an increase of 21.0 per cent over the 17,065,821 tons reported in the same period last year. Total arrivals and departures in both services rose to 92,809 from 83,606 while registered net tonnage increased 13.8 per cent to 94,558,341 tons from 83,075,371.

During May, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with May, 1959, loadings of wheat and gypsum were down by 162,316 and 84,134 tons, respectively. However, increases in limestone (132,387 tons), iron ore (103,263 tons) and other commodities resulted in an overall increase of 191,681 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 1,014,924 tons. The largest increases were in iron ore, up by 411,758 tons, crude petroleum, by 369,323 tons, bituminous coal, by 180,721 tons and petroleum oils by 104,095 tons.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in wheat, petroleum oils and pulpwood. Although unloadings of wheat and barley were lower than in May, 1959, increases in logs, petroleum oils, pulpwood and other commodities resulted in an overall increase of 344,940 tons.

Shipping reports for May showed increased operations in all areas. Loadings in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were up 4.4 per cent to 4,834,451 tons, in the Great Lake area, 1.2 per cent to 3,398,082 tons and on the Pacific coast up 0.5 per cent to 1,822,048 tons. Cargoes unloaded showed an increase of 15.7 per cent in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, 17.5 per cent to 4,437,227 tons in the Great Lakes area and 16.9 per cent to 1,178,678 tons on the Pacific coast.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during May were: Montreal, 2,285,035 tons (2,183,730 in May, 1959); Seven Islands, 1,606,598 tons (1,706,412); Port Arthur, 1,248,302 tons (1,256,351); Vancouver, 1,144,043 tons (1,190,488); and Hamilton, 1,104,192 tons (804,413).
