SHIPPING STATISTICS

June, 1960

Freight handled at Canadian ports during June totalled 20,439,443 tons, an increase of 5.9 per cent over the 19,297,403 tons reported in June, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries increased 3.5 per cent to 6,247,536 tons from 6,036,033 while unloadings from foreign countries were up 23.2 per cent to 4,863,951 tons from 3,947,122. Coastwise shipping showed little change. Loadings rose to 4,548,859 tons from 4,537,904 with unloadings up to 4,779,097 tons from 4,776,344. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 32,726 from 32,146 while the registered net tonnage rose 5.4 per cent to 35,866,559 tons from 34,028,397.

For the period January-June, 1960, the volume of freight handled at Canadian ports rose 12.3 per cent to 65,014,715 tons from 57,900,759 in the same period last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 11.1 per cent to 35,029,868 tons from 31,520,690 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping aggregated 29,984,847 tons, a rise of 13.7 per cent over the 26,380,069 tons reported one year earlier. Arrivals and departures in both services rose to 125,535 from 115,752 while the registered net tonnage increased 11.4 per cent to 130,424,900 tons from 117,103,768.

During June cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, lumber and newsprint. Compared with June, 1959, loadings of wheat and gypsum were down by 212,987 and 103,277 tons, respectively. However, an increase of 248,398 tons in iron ore along with smaller increases in other commodities resulted in an overall increase of 211,503 tons. Unloadings from foreign countries were up by 916,829 tons. The largest increases were in crude petroleum, up by 410,167 tons, bituminous coal, by 376,927 tons and bauxite by 138,639 tons.

The greatest volume of coastwise shipping was recorded in pulpwood, wheat and petroleum oils. Decreases in wheat, iron ore and coal unloaded were largely offset by increases in pulpwood, logs and petroleum oils and the total was up by 2,753 tons.

Cargoes loaded in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were down 8.8 per cent to 5,202,881 tons, but rose 5.3 per cent to 3,157,206 tons in the Great Lakes area and 30.3 per cent to 2,436,308 tons on the Pacific coast. Unloadings increased 19.0 per cent to 4,355,916 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region, 1.7 per cent to 4,102,516 tons in the Great Lakes area and 15.3 per cent to 1,184,616 tons on the Pacific coast.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during June were: Montreal, 2,241,314 tons (2,230,137 in June, 1959); Seven Islands, 1,826,452 tons (2,069,294); Port Arthur, 1,256,712 tons (1,157,687); Vancouver, 1,242,596 tons (1,203,164) and Hamilton, 1,054,755 tons (923,814).
