SHIPPING STATISTICS

July, 1960

Freight handled at Canadian ports during July totalled 19,955,667 tons, a decrease of 3.2 per cent from the 20,612,934 tons reported in July, 1959. Loadings for foreign countries rose 19.0 per cent to 6,529,630 tons from 5,485,171, while foreign unloadings dropped 11.5 per cent to 4,314,063 tons from 4,874,535. In coastwise shipping, loadings decreased 13.0 per cent to 4,560,483 tons from 5,238,398, while unloadings were down 9.2 per cent to 4,551,491 tons from 5,014,830. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services decreased to 31,590 from 33,277 while the registered net tonnage rose 5.0 per cent to 37,884,461 tons from 36,068,778.

For the period January-July, 1960, the volume of freight handled at Canadian ports rose 8.2 per cent to 84,970,382 tons from 78,513,693 one year earlier. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 9.5 per cent to 45,873,561 tons from 41,880,396 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping increased 6.7 per cent to 39,096,821 tons from 36,633,297. Arrivals and departures in both services rose to 157,125 from 149,029 while the registered net tonnage increased 16.5 per cent to 168,309,361 tons from 144,484,384.

During July, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, gypsum, wheat, newsprint and lumber. Compared with July, 1959, loadings of wheat and barley were down. Shipments of iron ore, however were up by 1,063,660 tons, resulting in an overall increase of 1,044,459 tons. Unloadings from foreign countries were down by 560,472 tons. Decreases in bituminous coal of 434,573 tons, petroleum oils of 160,007 tons and limestone, 100,432 tons, more than offset increases in other commodities.

The greatest volume of coastwise shipping was recorded in pulpwood, wheat and petroleum oils. Although unloadings of logs and pulpwood were greater than in July, 1959, decreased shipments of wheat, bituminous coal and other commodities resulted in an overall decrease of 463,339 tons.

Loadings increased 7.6 per cent to 6,313,615 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region but dropped 11.9 per cent to 3,023,195 tons in the Great Lakes area, due largely to a decline in wheat shipments. On the Pacific coast loadings rose 23.1 per cent to 1,753,303 tons. Unloadings in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region were down 3.7 per cent to 4,059,715 tons and in the Great Lakes area down 23.0 per cent to 3,757,388 tons. On the Pacific coast, however, unloadings were up 31.4 per cent to 1,048,451 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during July were: Seven Islands, 2,261,721 tons (1,836,133 in July, 1959); Montreal, 2,193,695 tons (2,567,193); Port Arthur, 1,125,054 tons (1,430,776); Hamilton, 1,068,692 tons (1,174,358); and Vancouver, 1,012,943 tons (900,028).
