## SHIPPING STATISTICS

August, 1960

Freight handled at Canadian ports during August totalled 20,449,933 tons, an increase of 7.3 per cent over the 19,060,133 tons reported in August, 1959. Cargoes loaded for foreign countries rose 12.0 per cent to 6,221,702 tons from 5,553,344 and cargoes unloaded from foreign countries increased 7.1 per cent to 4,942,232 tons from 4,616,327. In coastwise shipping, loadings increased 9.1 per cent to 4,721,609 tons from 4,327,476, while unloadings were up slightly to 4,564,390 tons from 4,562,986. Vessel arrivals and departures in both services increased to 35,494 from 30,959 with registered net tonnage up to 37,414,206 tons from 33,430,477.

For the period January-August, 1960, the volume of freight handled at Canadian ports rose 8.0 per cent to 105,420,315 tons from 97,573,826 last year. Cargoes loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries increased 9.6 per cent to 57,037,495 tons from 52,050,067 while the volume of freight handled in coastwise shipping rose 6.3 per cent to 48,382,820 tons from 45,523,759. Arrivals and departures in both services increased to 192,619 from 179,988, with registered net tonnage up to 205,723,567 tons from 177,914,861.

During August, cargoes loaded in greatest volume for foreign countries were iron ore, wheat, gypsum, newsprint and lumber. Compared with August, 1959, loadings of barley, gypsum and limestone were down. Increased shipments of lumber, up 165,588 tons, wheat, up 146,260 tons, iron ore, up 112,618 tons, and smaller increases in other commodities resulted in an overall increase of 668,358 tons. Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries were up by 325,905 tons. Increases in iron ore and crude petroleum of 750,475 and 275,290 tons, respectively, more than offset decreases in bituminous coal, petroleum oils and other commodities.

In coastwise shipping the greatest volume was recorded in pulpwood, petroleum oils, and wheat. Decreases in wheat, iron ore and bituminous coal unloaded were offset by increases in logs, pulpwood and other commodities and the total was up by 1,404 tons.

Loadings in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region at 6,241,801 tons showed little change from the previous year, but rose 7.6 per cent in the Great Lakes area to 2,828,717 tons while on the Pacific coast, due to increased shipments of pulpwood, loadings almost doubled, rising to 1,872,793 tons from 998,742. Unloadings were up 1.6 per cent to 4,108,854 tons in the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River region but down 6.0 per cent to 4,211,322 tons in the Great Lakes area. On the Pacific coast unloadings were up 81.4 per cent to 1,186,446 tons.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight during August were: Seven Islands, 2,190,657 tons (2,598,441 in August, 1959); Montreal, 2,004,474 tons (2,252,362); Hamilton, 1,246,006 tons (1,164,935); Vancouver, 1,056,262 tons (680,291) and Port Arthur, 1,055,606 tons (1,071,691).
