CANAL STATISTICS

PREFACE

The canal statistics are collected through the local agents of the Department of Railways and Canals and compiled by the Transportation Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Iron ore traffic through the canals at Sault Ste. Marie showed a marked revival during 1923 aggregating 59,356,943 tons, as against 42,227,338 tons during 1922 and 22,593,323 tons during 1921. The 1921 tonnage was the smallest since 1903, and the 1923 tonnage was surpassed only by the records of the war years, 1916-17 and 1918 by 7 per cent, 3 per cent and 2 per cent respectively. Wheat shipments through the Sault Ste. Marie, Welland and St. Lawrence canal systems passed all previous records.

The diversion of United States corn from Montreal caused decreases in corn traffic through the Welland and St. Lawrence canals, but other grains showed substantial increases over 1922 shipments, while total traffic through these two canals showed increases of 364,493 tons and 221,609 tons respectively. The Canadian traffic through these three canals was 10 per cent greater than during 1922, and Canadian vessels also carried 10 per cent more cargoes.

Complete details of the 1923 traffic on the several canals are given in tables on pages 23-47 and data, including lake freight rates, on Canadian grain through the canals, are shown in tables on pages 15-23.

A short historical and descriptive sketch of the several canals has been included in the report on pages 5 and 6.

STATISTIQUE DES CANAUX

PRÉFACE

La statistique des canaux est colligée par l'intermédiaire des agents locaux du ministère des Chemins de fer et Canaux et compilée par la Section des Transports du Bureau Fédéral de la Statistique.

Au cours de l'année 1923, le trafic du minerai de fer par les canaux du Sault Ste-Marie manifesta une plus grande activité que précédemment, car il en a été transporté 59,356,943 tonnes, au lieu de 42,227,338 tonnes en 1922 et 22,593,323 tonnes en 1921. Les chiffres de 1921 n'ont jamais été aussi bas depuis 1903; quant au tonnage de 1923, il n'a été surpassé que dans les années de guerre 1916, 1917 et 1918 qui l'excèdent de 7 p.c., 3 p.c. et 2 p.c. respectivement. La circulation du blé dans les canaux du Sault Ste-Marie, Welland et du Saint-Laurent a dépassé tous les records précédents.

Le maïs des Etats-Unis ayant été diverti du port de Montréal, ce trafic diminua dans les canaux du Saint-Laurent et du canal Welland, mais les autres céréales présentèrent des augmentations substantielles sur 1922 et la totalité du trafic de ces deux canaux a augmenté de 364,493 tonnes et 221,609 respectivement. Le trafic canadien de ces trois canaux dépassait de 10 p.c. celui de 1922 et le tonnage de la batellerie canadienne lui fut également supérieure de 10 p.c.

On trouvera les détails complets de l'activité des différents canaux en 1923 dans les tableaux des pages 00 et 00; les détails de la circulation du grain canadien dans les canaux, y compris les taux de transport sur les lacs, figurent aux tableaux des pages 00 et 00.

Un bref aperçu historique de chaque des canaux sert d'introduction à ce rapport.

HISTORICAL AND DESCRIPTIVE SKETCH OF CANADIAN CANALS

In the following, an abridged, descriptive and historical account is given of each of the canals of Canada.

ST. LAWRENCE CANALS.—*Lachine Canal.*—The first attempts at surmounting the Lachine rapids by means of a canal were made in the early years of the 19th Century. Owing to lack of funds, however, this first project was never completed. The present canal, lying along the same route, was constructed between the years 1818 and 1825. It had seven locks and accommodated vessels of $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet draft. In 1843 an enlargement was commenced which, completed in 1848, provided larger and deeper locks with 9 feet of water. In 1885 another enlargement was completed and the present canal with five locks 270 feet by 45 feet having 14 feet of water on lock sills was opened for traffic.

Soulange Canal.—This canal, which overcomes the Cascades, Cedar and Coteau rapids, occurs next in order on the St. Lawrence route. It is the longest and deepest of the St. Lawrence River canals, being 14 miles from end to end and having five locks 280 feet by 45 feet with 15 feet of water on sills. It is situated on the north side of the river between Cascades Point and Coteau Landing. Under the French regime four small canals with a depth of only $2\frac{1}{2}$ feet were constructed which were reconstructed and enlarged by the British authorities in 1845, increasing the depth to 9 feet. Further improvements were made and the present canal was opened to traffic in 1899.

Cornwall Canal.—From the head of the Soulange canal there is a stretch of 31 miles of navigable water through Lake St. Francis to the foot of the Long Sault rapids. The Cornwall canal, by which these rapids are surmounted, lies between the town of Cornwall and Dickinson's Landing. It is $11\frac{1}{4}$ miles long and has six locks 270 feet by 45 feet with 14 feet of water over lock sills. This canal was first constructed between 1834 and 1843 with a depth of only 9 feet and was enlarged to the present dimensions in 1901.

Williamsburg Canals.—After a navigable stretch of 5 miles, a series of three canals, the Farran's Point, Rapide Plat and Galops are entered. These are known as the Williamsburg canals and extend, including river reaches between, for a distance of $26\frac{1}{4}$ miles to the town of Cardinal from which point river and lake navigation become possible without interruption until the Welland canal is entered 228 miles farther west. The three canals of this system were all first constructed between the years 1843 and 1847 with a minimum depth of 9 feet. They were enlarged between the years 1897 and 1901 with locks 270 feet by 45 feet and a depth of 14 feet on lock sills. These canals are used mostly by ascending vessels, it being possible, except at low stages of the river, for down-bound vessels to safely navigate all the rapids.

WELLAND CANAL.—This important waterway, which overcomes the fall of 325 feet of the Niagara river, connects Lake Ontario with Lake Erie. The necessity for such a canal became apparent as far back as 1816. Great difficulty was however, experienced in the financing of the undertaking, and it was not until 1829 that the first route between the two lakes was opened. This original

canal extended from Port Dalhousie on lake Ontario to the town of Port Robinson, where a connection was made with the Welland river. The course was down this river to its junction with the Niagara river and thence to lake Erie. This circuitous route was not found satisfactory and between the years 1831 and 1833 the canal was extended along its present route from Port Robinson to Port Colborne. As it was not then found practicable to reduce the summit level to that of lake Erie, a feeder from the Grand river at Dunnville had to be constructed. The reduction of this summit level was not effected until 1881. The original canal, however, was improved and deepened and by 1846 the first constructed wooden locks had been replaced by masonry with a depth of 9 feet of water on the sills. The present canal, $26\frac{3}{4}$ miles in length and with locks of the same dimensions as those of the St. Lawernee canals, was completed in 1887. Construction of the Welland Ship canal was commenced in 1913 and when completed this canal will have a length of only 25 miles with seven lift locks having dimensions of 800 feet by 80 feet with 30 feet of water over sills. Entrance to the canal will be made at Port Weller, about 3 miles east of Port Dalhousie, and between this point and Allanburg an entirely new route will be followed but the line of the present canal will be adhered to between Allanburg and Port Colborne, with the exception of two short diversions.

SAULT STE. MARIE CANAL.—From Port Colborne to the foot of the St. Mary rapids, at the entrance to lake Superior, a distance of 574 miles, no obstructions to navigation are encountered. The Canadian lock at Sault Ste. Marie, Ontario and those on the American side of the St. Mary river were constructed to overcome the difference in level of 19 feet between lakes Huron and Superior. The earliest canal at this point was built in 1797-98 by the North-West Fur Company. It consisted of one lock 38 feet long and had 9 feet of water on the sills. This lock was destroyed in 1814 by United States troops and the canal was not reconstructed until 1853-55 when one lock was built on the United States side of the river. This has since been superseded by four more modern locks, constructed at intervals between the years 1881 and 1919. The Canadian canal was completed in 1895 and consists of a single lock 900 feet by 60 feet with a minimum depth of water on sills of 18 feet 3 inches.

ST. PETERS CANAL.—This, the most easterly of the Canadian canals, crosses an isthmus half a mile in width on the southerly side of Cape Breton Island, N.S., and connects St. Peters bay with the Bras d'Or lakes from the northerly end of which access is had to the Atlantic ocean. It consists of one tidal lock 300 feet by 48 feet with a depth of 18 feet on sills, first constructed in 1869 but extensively repaired and improved between the years 1912 and 1917.

CHAMBLY CANAL.—The inland water route between Montreal and New York is down the St. Lawrence river, up the Richelieu river through lake Champlain, Champlain canal and down the Hudson river. Rapids on the Richelieu river are passed by a lock 200 feet by 45 feet with 7 feet of water on sills at Sorel, constructed in 1844-49 and by a canal between Chambly and St. Johns with 9 locks the smallest of which is 118 feet by $22\frac{1}{2}$ feet with $6\frac{1}{2}$ feet of water on sills. Construction of this canal was commenced in 1831 and completed in its present state in 1858.

OTTAWA CANALS.—The navigation of the Ottawa river between the Port of Montreal and the city of Ottawa is effected by means of the Lachine canal, the Ste. Anne lock and the Carillon and Grenville canals. The Lachine canal, which forms part of the St. Lawrence system, has already been described. The Ste. Anne lock, situated at the westerly end of the island of Montreal, surmounts the Ste. Anne rapids at the junction of the Ottawa river with lake St. Louis. Between the years 1840 and 1843 the first lock was constructed, its

dimensions being 190 feet by 45 feet with 6 feet of water and an additional lock 10 feet longer and 3 feet deeper was constructed between the years 1880 and 1883. Both locks are now in operation. Between Carillon and Grenville there were originally three canals, constructed by the Imperial Government between the years 1825 and 1833. The second of the three, the Chute a Blondeau was abandoned after the completion of the Carillon dam in 1881. At this time also the Carillon and Grenville canals were reconstructed, the work being fully completed in 1884. The locks on these canals are of the same dimensions as the newer of the two locks at Ste. Anne. From the head of the Grenville canal the river is navigable to the city of Ottawa.

The navigation of the upper Ottawa is obstructed by falls and rapids and such efforts as have been made towards overcoming these obstacles have been of a purely local character. The Culbute canal with two wooden locks by which a stretch of 117 miles of river was opened to navigation between Bryson and Des Joachims, was completed in 1876 and maintained until 1894. An effort was also made between 1854 and 1856 to construct a canal at the Chats falls, but the work proved very expensive and was abandoned.

RIDEAU CANAL.—This canal, constructed by the British Government between the years 1826 and 1832 and providing a continuous water way between the cities of Ottawa and Kingston owed its inception to purely military considerations incident to the War of 1812. It consists of a series of natural water courses connected by short cuttings and locks starting with the Rideau river at Ottawa rising to a summit at the Upper Rideau lake and finally entering lake Ontario by the Cataraqui river. This canal with a total length of $126\frac{1}{4}$ miles was transferred to the Provincial Government in 1857 and after Confederation taken over by the Federal authorities. It has forty-seven locks 134 feet by 33 feet with 5 feet of water on sills. From the northerly end of the lower Rideau lake, a branch, 7 miles in length, extends to the town of Perth.

TRENT CANAL.—In the Trent canal is comprised a system of navigation which extends from Trenton on the bay of Quinte to Georgian bay on lake Huron. The route of this canal follows the river Trent to Rice lake, thence by the Otonabee river to Peterborough from which point by a series of rivers, lakes and artificial channels it reaches lake Simcoe, passing next into lake Couchiching and Sparrow lake, from thence it follows the line of the Severn river to Honey harbour on Georgian bay. Up to the present the canal has been opened to navigation as far west as Sparrow lake and by the use of marine railways at Swift rapids and Big Chute motor vessels of five tons may complete the passage to Georgian bay via Port Severn.

The first proposals in regard to this route were made in 1827 and between 1833 and 1835 a wooden lock was constructed at Bobcaygeon which made possible the continuous navigation of lakes Chemong, Buckhorn, Pigeon and Sturgeon and thence via the Scugog river to Lindsay. In 1837 works were commenced on the Trent river and carried on intermittently until 1844 by which date continuous navigation had been established between Healey falls and Peterborough and on the unconnected reach between Frankford and Percy Landing. Further construction was carried on by the Provincial Government between 1869 and 1872 which developed communication between a number of isolated reaches west of Peterborough. Between the years 1883 and 1887 this development was continued and resulted in the establishment of through communication between Stoney and Balsam lakes. By the construction of locks and other works between Peterborough and Stoney lake and between Balsam lake and lake Simcoe in the years 1895 to 1907 a continuous route became established between Healey falls and lake Couchiching which, with the Scugog route opened over 200 miles of inland navigation without outlet to the Great Lakes. On this route two large hydraulic liftlocks were constructed,

one at Peterborough capable of lifting an 800-ton vessel vertically 65 feet and another at Kirkfield with a lift of 49 feet. The construction of all the works necessary for through navigation between Trenton and Rice lake was completed between the years 1908 and 1918. Through traffic on this canal is limited by a depth of 6 feet through locks 134 feet by 33 feet. On the Ontario-Rice Lake division, however, the locks are 175 feet by 33 feet with a depth of 8 feet 4 inches.

THE MURRAY CANAL,—An open waterway across the isthmus of the Prince Edward County peninsula, may in a sense be considered as forming part of the Trent Canal system. Vessels leaving the Trent canal at Trenton can by this route pass directly into lake Ontario. The first proposal to construct this canal appears to have been made in 1796 and the project was discussed frequently thereafter in the Provincial Legislature. Construction however was not begun until 1882 and was completed in 1889.

ST. ANDREWS LOCK, with dimensions of 215 feet by 45 feet with 17 feet of water, overcomes rapids on the Red river, 15 miles north of Winnipeg and was opened to traffic in 1910.
