# CANAL STATISTICS

## PREFACE

The Canal Statistics are collected through the local agents of the Department of Railways and Canals and compiled by the Transportation Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

A feature of the 1924 canal traffic was the large increase in grain down the Welland and St. Lawrence Canals, materially increasing the total traffic on those canals beyond that of any previous year. On the Welland canal the grain shipments aggregated 3,644,330 tons, wheat amounting to 2,994,419 tons or 99,813,960 bushels. This was an increase over 1923 traffic of 24,495,430 bushels of Canadian wheat and 11,472,430 bushels of United States wheat. Another feature was the movement of Canadian wheat from the head of the lakes to Buffalo, New York, where it was transferred to Welland Canal boats and forwarded to Montreal. During the year, 16,645,000 bushels were shipped in this manner, the average freight rate for the season on this route being 8.79 cents per bushel, which was slightly lower than either the through rate to Montreal (8.99 cents) or the combined rate on wheat transhipped at Port Colborne (9.04 cents).

The iron ore traffic, which is the predominating traffic through the Sault Ste. Marie Canals, showed a decrease from that of 1923 of 16,865,306 tons or 28 per cent. It should be noted, however, that the iron ore traffic of 1923 was exceeded only by that of 1916, 1917 and 1918.

During the season 13 cargoes consisting of pulpwood (7), pebbles (2), iron and steel (2), sugar (1) and china clay (1) passed up the St. Lawrence Canals from English, European, Newfoundland and United States Atlantic ports. Two vessels brought up five cargoes of pulpwood; five of the vessels were on their way up to enter the grain trade and three of them made only one trip.

Complete details of the traffic on the several canals are given in tables on pages 16 to 43 and summaries back to 1900 are shown on pages 43 to 49 inclusive.

## STATISTIQUE DES CANAUX

### PRÉFACE

La statistique des canaux est colligée par les agents locaux du ministère des Chemins de fer et des Canaux et compilée par la section des Transports du Bureau Fédéral de la Statistique.

Les transports par eau en l'année 1924 se signalent surtout à l'attention par l'énorme augmentation du grain ayant descendu le canal Welland et les canaux du St-Laurent, portant le trafic de ces canaux à des chiffres jusqu'alors inconnus. Les céréales ayant emprunté le canal Welland représentaient 3,644,330 tonnes, dont 2,994,419 tonnes ou 99,813,960 boisseaux de blé. Ceci, comparé au trafic de 1923, représente une augmentation de 24,495,430 boisseaux de blé canadien et 11,472,430 boisseaux de blé des Etats-Unis. Une autre particularité remarquable fut le mouvement du blé canadien depuis la tête des lacs jusqu'à Buffalo, N.Y., d'où il fut rechargé sur les bateaux du canal Welland et expédié à Montréal. Au cours de l'année, 16,645,000 boisseaux ont été expédiés de cette manière au coût moyen de 8.79 cents par boisseau, légèrement inférieur tant au tarif du transport direct à Montréal, (8.99 cents) qu'au coût du transport du blé transbordé à Port Colborne (9.04 cents).

Le transport du minerai de fer, qui est le trafic essentiel des canaux du Sault Ste-Marie, fut inférieur à celui de 1923 de 16,865,306 tonnes ou 28 p.c. Il est toutefois à considérer qu'en 1923 le trafic du minerai de fer avait été très considérable, n'étant dépassé que par ceux de 1916, 1917 et 1918.

Durant la saison, 13 cargaisons venant soit du Royaume-Uni, soit d'autres ports européens, soit des ports atlantiques des Etats-Unis ou enfin de Terre-Neuve, ont remonté les canaux du Saint-Laurent; elles consistaient en bois à pulpe (7), gravier (2) fer et acier (2), sucre (1) et porcelaine (1). Deux navires ont amené cinq cargaisons de bois à pulpe; cinq de ces navires, après leur déchargeement, ont servi au transport du blé et trois d'entre eux ne firent qu'un seul voyage.

Les détails complets du trafic des différents canaux sont donnés dans les tableaux des pages 16 à 43; la statistique rétrospective, en remontant jusqu'à 1900, fait l'objet des tableaux des pages 43 à 49 inclusivement.


