

CANAL STATISTICS

PREFACE

The canal statistics are collected through the local agents of the Department of Railways and Canals and compiled by the Transportation Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

The report for 1925 has been enlarged to include analyses of the traffic on the several canals, which show the movement of light vessels or vessels in ballast, the country of registry of all vessels using the canals, the country of origin of cargoes carried and of ports of origin and of destination. In all these statistics each vessel is counted as one vessel each time it passes through a canal; where vessels stop at points on the canal and do not go through the entire length, they are counted when entering and again when leaving on the return trip.

The locks at Sault Ste. Marie opened 11 days earlier than in 1924 and closed 3 days later. The traffic through both the Canadian and United States locks was heavier than during the previous year by 9,836,854 tons. This was more than accounted for by the increase of 11,382,167 tons in iron ore. Wheat shipments were heavier by 95,346 tons, or 3,178,200 bushels, but other grains showed a decrease of 669,369 tons.

The Welland and St. Lawrence canals were open a slightly longer period than in 1924 and the freight traffic was the greatest in their histories. The number of vessels, the registered vessel tonnage and the freight tonnage, were all larger than those of 1924, which were the previous high records.

On the Welland canal the big increase was in United States cargoes which increased by 364,238 tons over the 1924 shipments. United States barley and oats were considerably heavier, but wheat shipments were reduced almost 50 per cent and bituminous coal showed an increase of 475,803 tons. Canadian grain shipments including flour were 91,312 tons heavier than in 1924, the increases in barley and oats more than offsetting the decline in wheat shipments. The transhipment at Buffalo of Canadian grain from Fort William-Port Arthur to Montreal continued, the reports showing 17,779,433 bushels of wheat transhipped, besides considerable quantities of barley, rye and oats.

The largest increase in traffic on the St. Lawrence canals was in United States bituminous coal which increased by 388,177 tons. The coal traffic, however, was not as heavy as during 1916 to 1920 inclusive. The largest factor in the increased traffic during the past five years has been the grain shipments which increased from 467,093 tons in 1920 to 3,489,614 tons in 1925. This was 73,853 tons below the 1924 grain tonnage on account of large declines in both Canadian and United States wheat. The coal strikes in the United States anthracite coal mines greatly affected the anthracite coal traffic on the Sault Ste. Marie, Welland, St. Lawrence and Champlain canals and the Nova Scotia labour trouble affected the movement of bituminous coal through the St. Peters Canal.

Ocean traffic up the St. Lawrence canals during 1925 increased from 34 cargoes in 1923 and 35 cargoes in 1924 to 52 cargoes consisting of Welsh coal, Newfoundland and Nova Scotia iron, china clay from England, sugar from Halifax and New York, and pulpwood and miscellaneous freight from various ports. Some of the vessels bringing these cargoes up remained in the grain trade on the lakes and some were regular lake boats, the remainder being tramps which worked their way back, as few vessels secured full cargoes for points outside the St. Lawrence Gulf.

STATISTIQUES DES CANAUX, 1925

PRÈFACE

La statistique des canaux est colligée par les agents locaux du ministère des Chemins de fer et Canaux et compilée par la Section des Transports du Bureau Fédéral de la Statistique.

Le cadre du rapport de 1925 a été agrandi, de manière à y faire entrer une analyse du trafic des canaux, relatant le mouvement des navires vides ou naviguant sur l'est, le port d'attache de tous les navires naviguant sur les canaux, le pays d'origine des cargaisons transportées, le port de départ et celui de destination. Dans tous ces calculs, un navire est compté pour une unité, chaque fois qu'il passe dans un canal; les navires s'arrêtant en route sont comptés d'abord en entrant dans le canal puis une seconde fois au voyage de retour.

Les écluses du Sault Ste-Marie s'ouvrirent onze jours plus tôt qu'en 1924 et se fermèrent trois jours plus tard. L'ensemble du trafic, tant du côté Canadien que du côté des États-Unis, a dépassé de 9,836,854 tonnes celui de l'année précédente. A lui seul le minerai de fer présente un gain de 11,382,167 tonnes. Les expéditions de blé ont été plus élevées de 95,346 tonnes ou 3,178,200 boisbeaux, mais les autres céréales ont décliné de 669,369 tonnes.

La période de circulation du canal Welland et des canaux du Saint-Laurent fut légèrement plus longue qu'en 1924, et leur trafic dépassa tous les chiffres précédents. Le nombre des navires, leur tonnage et le volume de leur cargaison ont excédé les chiffres de 1924, lesquels constituaient eux-mêmes un record.

La plus forte augmentation constatée dans le canal Welland fut constituée par les cargaisons en provenance des États-Unis, qui dépassèrent de 364,238 tonnes les expéditions de 1924. L'orge et l'avoine des États-Unis y passèrent en plus grande abondance, mais les cargaisons de blé fléchirent de presque 50 p.c.; la houille bitumineuse augmenta de 475,803 tonnes. Les expéditions de céréales et de farine canadienne excéderent de 91,312 tonnes celles de 1924, l'accroissement des cargaisons d'orge et d'avoine compensant et au delà la baisse des expéditions de blé. Le transbordement à Buffalo du grain canadien allant de Fort William-Port Arthur à Montréal s'est continué, le rapport faisant porter ce transbordement sur 17,779,433 boisbeaux de blé, outre des quantités considérables d'orge, de seigle et d'avoine.

L'augmentation la plus forte du trafic des canaux du Saint-Laurent consista en houille bitumineuse venant des États-Unis, à concurrence de 388,177 tonnes; cependant les transports de charbon furent moins élevés que durant la période 1916-1920 inclusivement. L'élément le plus important de l'accroissement du trafic durant les cinq dernières années réside dans les expéditions de céréales, qui passèrent de 467,093 tonnes en 1920 à 3,489,614 tonnes en 1925, chiffres inférieurs de 73,853 tonnes à celui de 1924, en raison du déclin considérable des cargaisons de blé, tant du Canada que des États-Unis. Les grèves des mineurs d'anthracite aux États-Unis ont grandement affecté le trafic de l'anthracite sur les canaux de Sault Ste-Marie, Welland, Saint-Laurent et Chambly; d'autre part, les différends survenus entre ouvriers et patrons dans les houillères de la Nouvelle-Ecosse se sont répercutés sur le mouvement de la houille bitumineuse dans le canal Saint-Pierre.

Le trafic océanique ayant remonté le canal Saint-Laurent durant 1925 passa de 34 cargaisons en 1923 et 35 cargaisons en 1924 à 52 cargaisons, consistant en houille du pays de Galles, fer de Terre-Neuve et de la Nouvelle-Ecosse, porcelaine venant d'Angleterre, sucre venant soit d'Halifax, soit de New York, bois à pulpe et cargaisons diverses en provenance de différents ports. Quelques-uns des navires ayant transporté ces cargaisons furent affectés au transport des céréales sur les lacs, certains d'entre eux étant particulièrement adaptés à la navigation des lacs, tandis que les autres cherchaient une cargaison de retour qu'ils ne trouvaient le plus souvent que partiellement; en fait, très peu de navires se procurèrent une cargaison complète pour des ports au delà du golfe Saint-Laurent.
