CANAL STATISTICS

PREFACE

The canal statistics of Canada are collected through the local agents of the Department of Railways and Canals and compiled by the Transportation Branch of the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Navigation was late in opening in 1926, being over three weeks later than in 1925 at the Sault Ste. Marie Canals, over two weeks later at the Welland canal, and approximately one week later at the St. Lawrence canals. Bad weather set in early in December and shipping was greatly reduced, the vessel passages at the Sault Ste. Marie locks numbering only 318 for December, 1926, as against 490 for December, 1925. Despite these handicaps the traffic through the St. Lawrence canals was only 1.3 per cent less than the record made in 1925, and on the Welland canal only 7.5 per cent less.

The traffic on both the St. Lawrence and Welland canals was affected by the small oat crop. Canadian oats through the St. Lawrence canal fell off 157,334 tons and United States oats were lighter by 92,078 tons. Rye shipments also were lighter, Canadian rye declining 54,978 tons and United States rye 22,999 tons. Barley and corn showed increases, and while United States wheat shipments were practically the same as in 1925, Canadian wheat increased by 100,916 tons, or 3,363,860 bushels. The bituminous coal traffic down the canal was lighter by 210,872 tons, which was replaced in the Montreal market to some extent with Nova Scotia coal. Pulpwood upbound fell off 11,688 tons.

The changes in traffic on the Welland canal were much the same as on the St. Lawrence canals, except that the decrease in bituminous coal was 321,397 tons, while upbound pulpwood showed an increase of 4,478 tons.

Only in 1916, 1917, and 1923 was the traffic heavier through the Canadian and United States locks at Sault Ste. Marie than it was in 1926. Iron ore traffic was heavy, amounting to 57,647,399 tons; wheat traffic was lighter than in 1925 by 20,863,097 bushels; and other grains were 49,330,459 bushels lighter. Bituminous coal tonnage increased by 978,041 tons and anthracite coal increased by 561,505 tons. Total traffic showed an increase over 1925 of 3,809,916 tons.

The total traffic on all Canadian canals during the year amounted to 13,477,663 tons, which was 653,004 tons less than in 1925.

Ocean traffic up the St. Lawrence canals was heavier by far than for any previous year. The number of vessels totalled 169, and the number of cargoes 131, the other 38 vessels being in ballast. Eighty-seven vessels which were brought up to Detroit to be dismantled, and the majority of which were loaded with scrap iron, helped to swell this total, but the cargoes other than these were in excess of the cargoes from outside ports during other years. On account of strikes, no Welsh coal came up after May, the principal cargoes being iron and steel from Sydney, N.S., pulpwood from Newfoundland and Atlantic ports, sugar, china clay, pebbles and general merchandise. Only 7 cargoes were reported down the canals for European and Atlantic ports, although it is probable vessels destined to Montreal filled out their cargoes and continued on down the St. Lawrence river.

During the season, 14 Norwegian vessels engaged in the grain trade on the lakes, bringing coal, pebbles, sugar and pulpwood over at the beginning of the season and returning at the close of the season with grain. Twelve of them cleared for Montreal on their last trip where undoubtedly they loaded to deeper draughts than the canals permit.

Tables 11, 12 and 13 show separately the average freight rates for transportation and for transportation including winter storage. It is customary for vessels at the close of the season to quote rates which include storage. Such cargoes are carried to the destination and unloaded into the elevators during the winter as instructed by the shipper. In a few cases the grain is stored in the vessels at the head of the lakes and brought down the following spring. The rates which include storage charges have not been included in the averages for the season.

STATISTIQUE DES CANAUX

PRÉFACE

La statistique des canaux du Canada est colligée par les agents locaux du ministère des Chemins de fer et Canaux et compilée par la Section des Transports du Bureau Fédéral de la Statistique.

La navigation s'est tardivement ouverte en 1926, soit environ trois semaines plus tard qu'en 1925, aux canaux du Sault Ste-Marie; au canal Welland elle était en retard de deux semaines et dans les canaux du Saint-Laurent d'environ une semaine. D'autre part, la rigueur du froid au commencement de décembre restreignit grandement la navigation; en effet, en décembre 1926, les écluses du Sault Ste-Marie n'ont vu passer que 318 navires, au lieu de 490 en décembre 1925. Nonobstant ces désavantages, le trafic des canaux du Saint-Laurent ne fut inférieur que de 1.3 p.c. aux chiffres de 1925, qui constituaient un record, et celui du canal Welland de 7.5 p.c.

La circulation des marchandises, tant sur les canaux du Saint-Laurent que sur le canal Welland, fut affectée par la mauvaise récolte d'avoine. L'avoine canadienne transportée sur les canaux du Saint-Laurent subit une réduction de 157,334 tonnes, et celle des Etats-Unis de 92,028 tonnes. Les expéditions de seigle, elles aussi, souffrirent, le seigle canadien ayant baissé de 54,978 tonnes et celui des Etats-Unis de 22,999 tonnes. Par contre, l'orge et le maïs augmentèrent; quant au blé provenant des Etats-Unis, les expéditions furent sensiblement les mêmes qu'en 1925, mais le blé canadien bénéficia d'une augmentation de 100,916 tonnes, soit 3,363,860 bateaux. Le charbon bitumineux descendant le canal subit une diminution de 210,872 tonnes, qui furent remplacées sur le marché de Montréal, dans une certaine mesure, par la houille de la Nouvelle-Ecosse. Le bois à pulpe remontant le canal baissa de 11,688 tonnes.

Le trafic du canal Welland ne différa guère de celui des canaux du Saint-Laurent, si ce n'est que la diminution sur le charbon bitumineux fut de 321,397 tonnes; d'autre part, le bois de pulpe remontant le canal présente une augmentation de 4,478 tonnes.

Le volume du trafic des canaux du Sault Ste-Marie, en 1926, ne fut dépassé qu'en 1916, 1917 et 1923. Le minerai de fer, comme de coutume, joue un rôle prépondérant, avec 57,647,399 tonnes; le trafic du blé fut inférieur de 20,863,097 bateaux à celui de 1925 et les autres céréales inférieures également de 49,330,459 bateaux. Le charbon bitumineux vit son tonnage s'augmenter de 978,041 tonnes et l'anthracite de 561,505 tonnes. En définitive, le trafic de 1926 dépassa de 3,809,916 tonnes celui de 1925.

Le trafic total de tous les canaux canadiens durant l'année s'est élevé à 13,477,663 tonnes, c'est-à-dire 653,004 tonnes de moins qu'en 1925.

Le trafic océanique ayant remonté les canaux du Saint-Laurent fut beaucoup plus considérable qu'en toute autre année. On dénombra 169 navires, dont 131 chargés et 38 sur lest. Quatre-vingt sept navires aménés à Détroit pour y être démantelés, dont la majorité furent chargés de ferraille, contribuèrent à éléver ce total; cependant, même en les éliminant, les autres cargaisons en provenance de ports extérieurs auraient suffi à cette tâche. En raison de la grève, il n'est pas arrivé de charbon gallois après le mois de mai, les principales cargaisons étant constituées par le fer et l'acier de Sydney, N.-E., le bois de pulpe de Terre-Neuve et des ports de l'Atlantique, le sucre, le kaolin, le gravier et d'autres marchandises. La Statistique n'a relevé que sept cargaisons ayant descendu les canaux à destination des ports européens ou des ports maritimes du Canada et des Etats-Unis, quoiqu'il soit probable que des navires ayant descendu les canaux sur lest aient pu se charger à Montréal.

Pendant le cours de la saison, 14 vaisseaux norvégiens se livrèrent au transport des céréales sur les lacs; en arrivant, ils avaient apporté du charbon, du gravier, du sucre et du bois à pulpe et ils sont repartis à la fin de la saison chargés de grain, 12 d'entre eux firent leur dernier voyage à destination de Montréal où, indubitablement, ils complétèrent leur cargaison.

Les tableaux 11, 12 et 13 relèvent séparément la moyenne des tarifs de fret soit simplement pour le transport, soit pour le transport et l'entreposage d'hiver. A la fin de la saison, les navires ont l'habitude de faire entrer les frais d'entreposage dans leurs tarifs. Ces cargaisons sont transportées à leur destination et déchargées dans les élévateurs pendant l'hiver, selon les instructions de l'expéditeur. Parfois, les navires, conservant le grain dans leurs soutes, passent l'hiver à la tête des lacs et transportent leurs cargaisons au printemps suivant. Les tarifs comportant les frais d'entreposage ne figurent pas dans les moyennes pour la saison.
