



SHIPPING REPORT

Fiscal Year 1940-41, Calendar Year 1941.

Shipping statistics for fiscal years prior to 1937-38 were compiled by the Department of National Revenue from summary reports compiled by the officers of that department at the various customs ports. These summary reports for fiscal years 1937-38, 1938-39 and 1939-40 were forwarded to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics and the shipping reports for those three fiscal years were published by the Bureau.

Effective April 1, 1940 a statistical report was inaugurated. This report is required from each vessel arriving at and departing from each Canadian port with certain exceptions. The reports are mailed to the Bureau by the Collector of Customs and Excise at each port, every day from the larger ports and weekly from the smaller ports. A reproduction of this shipping report form is included in this report as an appendix.

The shipping report is not required from (1) tugs and other vessels, not designed primarily for the transportation of freight or passengers, of less than 10 gross tons, (2) other vessels of less than 10 net tons, (3) fishing vessels which are not required by customs regulations to report arrivals and departures and (4) vessels arriving at and departing from ports at which officers of customs and excise are not stationed. These officers act as the collectors of these statistical reports.

The shipping report is made by the ship's officer or agent upon departure of the vessel, and the statistics for both the arrival and departure are shown on the one report. The exceptions to this procedure are (1) vessels intending to remain in port for some considerable time, and (2) scows and other vessels which have no officer in charge or which may be towed in by one tug and taken out by another tug. In these two cases a report is made covering the arrival and another report is made covering the departure. Also, for vessels making regular runs between fixed terminals the agent at each port is allowed to make one report each month covering all the trips made during the month instead of making a report for each trip. The monthly reports show the number of arrivals and of departures and all other data provided for on the reporting form. There are two objects in having one report for both arrival and departure: (1) the number of reports is reduced by a half, and (2) there is an assurance that data for vessel such as net tons, flag, etc. will be the same for both arrival and departure.

Shipping in previous reports has been divided into three classes of service:

- (1) Coasting, including vessels in service between Canadian ports, and fishing in Canadian waters.
- (2) Vessels trading between Canadian and United States ports on the Great Lakes and connecting rivers.
- (3) Sea going, including vessels trading between Canadian ports and ports in other countries reached via the sea.

In this report the second and third class have been combined into one and classed as "Foreign Service". Whereas previously no statistics were collected or compiled for cargoes of vessels in the second class, now all the vessels in foreign service are required to give details of cargoes unloaded from foreign countries or loaded for foreign countries, including United States ports on the Great Lakes and connecting rivers. Other countries of the British Commonwealth of Nations are treated as foreign countries in these shipping statistics.

Vessels in coasting service are not required by customs regulations to report any details of cargoes loaded or unloaded, and consequently statistics on water-borne traffic between Canadian ports are not available from shipping reports. The only report containing any information on this traffic is "Canal Statistics" published by this Bureau, which includes details of cargoes of all vessels using the Canadian canals and also the United States locks at Sault Ste. Marie. If a vessel in coasting service does not use any of these canals no statistics are available on the cargoes handled. The shipping reports do show vessels arriving and also departing in coasting service with cargo and in ballast.

Vessels in foreign service are required to report details of cargoes from foreign countries unloaded at each port and details of cargoes loaded at each port for foreign countries. These details are the tons weight in tons of 2,000 pounds or tons measurement of 40 cubic feet of each commodity of bulk cargo such as, coal, ore, oil, lumber, etc., or of general cargo. Many vessels with mixed cargoes report the tonnages of the principal commodities loaded or unloaded.

If a vessel arrives at a port and does not unload any cargo it is reported as arriving in ballast, irrespective of what cargo might be on board. Similarly, if a vessel departs from a port and has not loaded any freight at the port for a foreign country it is reported as departing in ballast.

Vessels in foreign service calling at two Canadian ports are reported as follows: vessels arriving from foreign countries are reported arriving in foreign service at each port and reported departing in coasting service from the first port, and vessels departing for foreign countries are reported departing in foreign service from each port and arriving in coasting service at the second port. Many vessels call at Quebec and at Victoria on their voyage to Montreal and to Vancouver respectively, and are reported in foreign and out coasting at Quebec and Victoria, and in foreign at Montreal and at Vancouver. Consequently if the same number of calls are not made for both inbound and outbound voyages the total number of vessels reported arriving in foreign service and departing in foreign service for the year will not balance.

Statistics for vessels in foreign service are punched on Hollerith cards; samples of the cards used are reproduced in the appendix. The headings of some of the columns require explanations.

- "W. Draft" - columns 29-30 of the 1924 card, is the maximum draft of the vessel when fully loaded.
- "Month" - column 39, is the month of departure when both departure and arrival or only departure is covered by the report, or month of arrival if only arrival is included.
- "Draft" - columns 40-41 is the fore or aft draft, whichever is the greater, of the vessel upon arrival.
- "Service" - column 42, is the service as indicated by the shipping report.
- "Lines" - column 43, is used for compilation purposes when more than one kind of cargo is reported.
- "Origin" - columns 44-45, is the country in which cargo was loaded. This is not necessarily the country exporting the freight.
- "Kind" - columns 46-47, is the kind of cargo unloaded.
- "C. From" - columns 57-58, is the country at which the vessel made the last call before arriving at the port. When a vessel makes calls at two Canadian ports these columns would be punched for "Canada" for the second port.
- "Dest." - columns 63-64, is the country for which the cargo was loaded.
- "C. For" - columns 76-77, is the first port of call after departing from the port.
The other columns require no further explanation.

Shipping statistics will be compiled on a calendar year basis only in subsequent reports. In this report are included statistics for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1941 and for the calendar year 1941. Data for the fiscal year have been compiled and shown for: (a) the nine months, April to December, 1940, and (b) the three months, January to March, 1941. This arrangement allows the elimination of duplications when computing totals for the two years. The periods are indicated in the tables by "A" for April to December 1940, by "B" for January to March 1941, by "T" for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1941, and by "1941" for the calendar year 1941. Where there were statistics for only "A" or "B", the data were not repeated for "T", and where there were no statistics for any of these three periods, "A", "B", and "1941", nothing was shown.

There is generally very little shipping on the Great Lakes during January, February and March due to ice conditions. The season of navigation usually extends from the middle of April to the middle of December or around 240 days. Consequently this change in shipping statistics from the fiscal year to the calendar year basis will have very little effect on the statistics for Great Lake ports, and the effect on statistics for Atlantic and Pacific ports is of importance only in these two years when the shift was made.

Statistics for vessels in coasting service were entered in journals and consequently can not be cross analyzed as extensively as statistics for vessels in foreign service.

Due to war conditions all the statistics available from the individual reports for these two years were not compiled. Also all the tables compiled were not included in this report. The statistics in the tables which were compiled are readily available to any person interested in them. They include information as outlined below.

A - Coast ing service.

(1) Vessels arrived and vessels departed by ports showing number and net tons for (a) total, (b) unrigged, (c) fishing sail, fishing power, (d) tugs, (e) passenger and freight (1) sail, (2) steam and motor divided into seven tonnage groups.

B - Foreign service.

Cargoes were divided into nine classes: 1. general, 2. coal, 3. grain, 4. iron and steel, 5. lumber and timber, 6. oil including gasoline, 7. ore and stone, 8. wood pulp and 9. miscellaneous.

For countries of origin and destinations the world was divided into 30 divisions. Some of these include only one country and other divisions include several countries such as, Central America, India, Burma and Ceylon, etc. Also for certain compilations Canadian ports were grouped into three groups, (1) Atlantic Coast and ports on the St. Lawrence River up to and including Montreal, (2) Great Lakes and connecting and tributary river ports and (3) Pacific Coast ports.

The tables compiled for foreign service included:

1. Vessels arrived at each port showing number and net tons for, (a) total, (b) with cargo, (c) in ballast, (d) deep sea fishing, (e) total number by 16 tonnage classes.
2. Vessels arrived at each port showing number and net tons for, (a) total, (b) steam, (c) motor, (d) sail, (e) unrigged, (f) tankers, (g) tugs, (h) pleasure boats.
3. Vessels arrived at each port by draft divided into 17 classes.
4. Vessels arrived or departed by country of registry for the three geographical divisions of Canada as described in the foregoing.
5. Vessels arrived and departed for each of the three divisions from and to each foreign country or area showing number of vessels and net tonnage.
6. Cargoes loaded at each port showing tons of each commodity class.
7. Cargoes loaded at each of the three geographical groups of ports for each foreign country or area showing tons of each commodity class.
8. Cargoes unloaded at each port showing tons of each commodity class.
9. Cargoes unloaded at each of the three geographical groups of ports from each foreign country or area showing tons of each commodity class.

In compiling data for vessels in foreign service for 1940 and 1941 the net tonnage of vessels was coded for tonnage classes, tons weight of cargoes was taken to the nearest hundredth ton and tons measurement to the nearest tenth ton. Consequently these data will be approximate only, although sufficiently close for statistical purposes. The card for 1942 was enlarged and actual tonnage data are being punched on the cards for 1942.

The Bureau gratefully acknowledges the assistance of the officials of the Department of National Revenue when inaugurating the new scheme of shipping statistics by means of the statistical reporting form and the excellent co-operation of the Local Collectors of Customs and Excise in collecting the reports at their respective ports.


