SHIPPING REPORT

This report for the calendar year 1945 is the fifth issued on Canadian shipping on a calendar year basis. The change from the fiscal to the calendar year was made in 1941 when statistics were compiled for the nine months, April - December 1940, the three months, January - March 1941, and the calendar year 1941. A description of the method of collecting and compiling the data from statistical reports made by vessels calling at Canadian ports and reproductions of the forms and cards were included in the 1941 report.

Coasting service includes vessels arriving from a Canadian port or departing for a Canadian port when no freight from a foreign port is unloaded or no freight for a foreign port is loaded. Under this definition a foreign vessel from a foreign country would be classed in coasting service when departing from one Canadian port for a second Canadian port, as well as vessels trading between Canadian ports. Foreign service includes vessels arriving from a foreign port as last port of call or departing for a foreign port as first port of call, or unloading freight from or loading freight for a foreign port. Vessels in foreign service include vessels classified in reports prior to 1941 as sea-going and trading between Canada and the United States on lakes and rivers.

If a vessel does not unload any freight or does not load any freight it is classed as arriving or departing, respectively, in ballast, irrespective of the amount of freight it might have on board. Because of these definitions a vessel may arrive twice in foreign service and depart in coasting service on the same trip and, consequently, the number of departures and arrivals in either class of service will not always be the same. Vessels built in port will also cause a difference in arrivals and departures. There are also certain customs regulations in respect to fishing vessels

that are responsible for some difference in reports of departures and arrivals.

In the current report Tables 4, 10 and 11 represent data not given in any of the previous reports in this series. Table 11 lists arrivals and departures of fishing vessels from customs ports only. Table 5 has been expanded to show cargo tonnage of vessels by country of registry. Other statistics available on request but not published in this report, include draft of vessels entering each port, vessels of each flag entering each port, etc.

In classifying vessels in coasting service as to size, all unrigged vessels, all tugs and all sail fishing vessels were grouped with the vessels of 10 to 99 net registered tons. Also, all vessels of over 4,000 net tons in coastal service were grouped with vessels 4,000 to 4,999 tons. This accounts for the average tonnage of coasting vessels in these two groups being greater in some cases than the maximum of the group. The number of vessels in coasting service of over 4,999 net tons are few except on the Great Lakes and the unrigged tugs and sail fishing vessels were grouped with these small vessels for convenience. All vessels in foreign service were classified in Tables 2 and 3 strictly according to their tonnages.

Cargoes:- Tables 6 to 9 include data on cargoes to and from foreign countries. Details of cargoes are shown only for the larger ports and when only one commodity was handled at these ports the commodity was shown and no total. Tonnages of each commodity listed are not complete in all cases. Considerable tonnage of these commodities is included under "General", but where vessels loaded or unloaded only one commodity or where vessels with general cargoes handled any of these commodities in large lots, the tonnage of the commodity was reported and compiled. Tonnage data were required to be reported in tons weight of 2,000 pounds or in tons measurement of 40 cu.ft., but because of the practice in previous years of reporting tons in long tons of 2,240 pounds there is a possibility that all vessels did not report their cargoes correctly.

Vessel Tonnage:- Reports are not required from cargo vessels of less than ten net tons. Tugs and other vessels not designed to carry cargoes are required to report gross tons instead of net tons and these gross tons are added to net registered tons of other vessels in this report. These gross tons are a small percentage of the total and consequently the effect is small. No reports are required from such vessels of less than ten gross tons.

The following data arrived too late for inclusion in the tables of the report.
