

## INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics on the commodities loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries at Canadian ports. Data are also given on the number and registered net tonnage of vessels arrived at and departed from Canadian ports in international seaborne shipping.

### Source

Shipping statistics are compiled from reports made by operators or agents of vessels which arrive at and depart from Canadian ports. With the exception of vessels of less than fifteen registered net tons, naval vessels, and fishing vessels, all vessels are required to complete "Shipping Reports". At ports where there are customs officers these officials act as agents for the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in collecting the reports and forwarding them to the Bureau. The reports which record the activity at non-customs ports are forwarded through the nearest customs office.

The co-operation of shipping operators, shipping agents, and the Customs and Excise Division of the National Revenue Department in collecting the statistics contained in this publication has continued to be excellent.

### Treatment of Data

A vessel is classed as being in foreign service when (1) it arrives from a foreign port as last port of call, or departs for a foreign port as first port of call; or (2) cargo is loaded for a foreign port, or unloaded from a foreign port; or (3) the registry of the vessel is other-than-Canadian or British Commonwealth (even though the vessel may have arrived at one Canadian port from another, or departed from one Canadian port for another).

A vessel is classed as being in coasting service when (1) it is of Canadian or British Commonwealth registry; and (2) it arrives at one Canadian port from another, or departs from one Canadian port for another; and (3) it unloads no freight from a foreign port, or loads no freight for a foreign port; or (4) it is of foreign registry, but is granted a waiver to engage in coasting service.

A vessel from a foreign port calling at two Canadian ports with foreign freight for the second port will be in foreign and out coasting at the first port and in foreign at the second port. Also, a vessel calling at two Canadian ports on a voyage to a foreign port and having loaded freight at the first port for a foreign port is out foreign at the first port and in coasting and out foreign at the second port. A vessel calling at several Canadian ports with final destination a foreign port is in coasting service into each port. It also is in coasting service out of each port, except the last unless freight for a foreign port is loaded. Because of the variety that is possible in vessel movements, the number of arrivals and departures in either international seaborne shipping or coastwise shipping will not always be the same.

Beginning the count of vessel arrivals and departures on January 1 and ending it on December 31 also causes a disparity in the number of arrivals and departures. Those vessels which arrive in December and depart in January of the next year will be counted only as departures in the statistics of the year in which they depart. Similarly, those vessels which arrive in December and depart in January of the next year will be counted only as arrivals in the statistics of the year in which they arrive.

If a vessel does not unload any freight, or does not load any freight, it is classed as arriving or departing, respectively, "in ballast", regardless of the amount of cargo it might have on board.

Appendix A is a list of the Canadian ports for which shipping data are tabulated separately. Because of space limitations, data for the complete list of ports is not published in either Part II or Part III of the "Shipping Report". Those ports for which data are not published are listed separately. Information on these ports can be obtained by forwarding a request to the Chief, Transportation Section, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa.

Appendix B is the list of commodities into which all cargoes which are loaded or unloaded at Canadian ports are grouped. This list is based on the *Standard Commodity Classification Manual* published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Because of space limitations, the description of the commodities which are listed in the tables are often abbreviated or incomplete. Reference to Appendix B, however, will enable users to obtain the complete description.

Also because of space limitations, the headings in the list of commodities have been excluded from the tables. The commodities, however, are listed in the tables in the same order as they appear in Appendix B.

The term "general cargo" which appears in the list of commodities refers to only those commodities which are not identified in the "Shipping Reports" as specific commodities. The term is not intended to indicate the distinction between bulk and other commodities.

The letters "n.e.s." which are found in the commodity listing mean "not elsewhere specified".

In 1963 two changes which affect port totals were made in the tabulating procedures. Shipments from Toquart, British Columbia, which clear customs at Port Alberni and which were formerly credited to Port Alberni, have been credited to Toquart. Shipments from Jedway, British Columbia, which clear customs at Prince Rupert and which were formerly credited to Prince Rupert have been included in the category "all other British Columbia ports".

## ANALYSIS OF DATA

In 1963 there were significant changes in several of the statistics which measure international seaborne shipping activity at Canadian ports:

Two ports which principally load iron ore moved in opposite directions. Port Cartier loaded 1,983,668 more tons of iron ore, amounting to a total of 7,112,380 tons, while loadings of iron ore at Bell Island decreased 316,148 tons, to a total of 678,227 tons. In three years Port Cartier has expanded from the status of a port which loaded no iron ore and concentrates to a port which is second only to Sept Isles in loadings of this commodity.

Three ports were the major beneficiaries among the many ports that were favourably affected by the upsurge in Canadian grain shipments in 1963. These ports are Baie Comeau, Montreal, and Trois Rivières.

The tonnage of corn handled at Baie Comeau increased by 430,308 tons, to a total of 1,345,519 tons. Of this total, 704,476 tons were received from U.S. Great Lakes ports, and 641,043 tons were loaded for foreign countries. It was only subsequent to the opening of the St. Lawrence Seaway in 1959 that Baie Comeau began to receive U.S. corn for transhipment overseas. Since then this trade has expanded considerably.

The tonnage of wheat handled at Baie Comeau almost doubled, to register a sizeable growth of 1,023,649 tons. Of the total of 2,122,738 tons of wheat handled at the port, 460,001 tons were unloaded from the United States, and 1,202,736 tons of Canadian wheat were shipped overseas. Similar to corn movements, wheat has been handled by Baie Comeau only since 1960.

As a result of the increases in corn and wheat tonnages and in other tonnages, the amount of freight which passed over the docks at Baie Comeau recorded a substantial increase of 1,880,535 tons. Of the total of 4,928,360 tons of cargo handled, 3,006,654 tons were loadings and 1,921,706 tons were unloadings.

Montreal was also affected by the increased grain trade. This port handled 779,944 tons of corn in 1963, compared to 447,561 tons in 1962. It also handled 2,562,636 tons of wheat, which was an increase of 1,037,233 tons. Of the total, 2,448,336 tons of wheat was Canadian. The remainder was wheat from the United States which was transshipped to overseas markets.

Significantly larger movements of corn and wheat were also recorded at Trois Rivières. All of the 483,790 tons of corn unloaded at Trois Rivières were from U.S. Great Lakes ports. In 1962, 281,533 tons of corn were received from this region. Loadings of corn amounted to 446,727 tons, compared to 265,096 tons. The amount of wheat handled at Trois

Rivières almost doubled, to 1,099,977 tons. Of this total, 265,108 tons were received from the United States.

The increases in corn and wheat tonnages were mainly responsible for the overall increase of 1,012,243 tons which was recorded at Trois Rivières. Total tonnages handled by this port amounted to 2,872,220 tons.

Important increases in bituminous coal unloadings occurred at four Ontario ports - Port Credit, Sault Ste. Marie, Toronto, and Windsor. Unloadings of this commodity at Port Credit more than doubled, to 1,016,842 tons. An increase of U.S. bituminous coal unloadings was also recorded at Sault Ste. Marie. This increase, of 388,793 tons, brought the total of bituminous coal unloadings at this port to 2,345,254 tons. An expansion in the demand for coal by utility installations and the increased industrial activity in the Great Lakes region are reflected in the amount of bituminous coal unloaded at Toronto. In 1962 this figure was 1,692,465 tons, but in 1963 it had increased to 2,734,881 tons. Windsor was another port which recorded a large increase in bituminous coal unloadings - of 373,079 tons.

In 1962 a new gypsum quarry was opened on the Strait of Canso, with loadings clearing from the customs port of Port Hawkesbury. In 1962 this port loaded 121,348 tons of gypsum. In 1963 loadings of this commodity expanded to 616,437 tons.

Reversing the trend of a yearly increase in unloadings of crude petroleum at Montreal, 1963 recorded a very large decrease, of 1,074,047 tons, to a total of 2,472,300 tons.

As a result of increases in shipments of various grains, soyabeans, and gasoline, the amount of cargo handled at Quebec increased by 799,950 tons, to a total of 2,508,307 tons.

Vancouver recorded increases in several commodities in 1963. As a result, the amount of cargo handled at this Pacific port expanded by 1,661,840 tons, to a record high of 10,026,420 tons.

Significant increases in the number of vessel arrivals and departures and in the size of their registered net tonnages were recorded at five ports - Baie Comeau, Port Cartier, Hamilton, Toronto, and Vancouver. In 1962 a total of 587 vessel arrivals and departures with a registered net tonnage of 2,990,240 tons were handled at the docks of Baie Comeau. In 1963 the number of vessel arrivals and departures had increased to 695, with a registered net tonnage of 4,050,116 tons. Port Cartier handled a total of 226 vessel arrivals and departures with a registered net tonnage of 2,170,628 tons in 1962, but a year later the port counted 389 vessel arrivals and departures of 3,468,950 registered net tons. The corresponding figures for Hamilton are 1,755 vessels of 8,163,230 registered net tons, and 1,845 vessels of

9,280,575 tons; for Toronto they are 2,378 vessels of 7,014,164 tons, and 3,072 vessels of 8,377,306 registered net tons; and for Vancouver they are 6,945 vessels of 19,271,641 tons, and 7,478 vessels of 20,284,849 registered net tons.
