



INTRODUCTION

This publication contains statistics on the commodities loaded for and unloaded from foreign countries at Canadian ports. Data are also given on the number and registered net tonnage of vessels arrived at and departed from Canadian ports in international seaborne shipping.

Source

Shipping statistics are compiled from reports made by operators or agents of vessels which arrive at and depart from Canadian ports. With the exception of vessels of less than fifteen registered net tons, naval vessels, and fishing vessels, all vessels are required to complete "Shipping Reports". At ports where there are customs officers these officials act as agents for the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in collecting the reports and forwarding them to the Bureau. The reports which record the activity at non-customs ports are forwarded through the nearest customs office.

The co-operation of shipping operators, shipping agents, and the Customs and Excise Division of the National Revenue Department in collecting the statistics contained in this publication has continued to be excellent.

Treatment of Data

Only data relating to those vessels which are engaged in port-to-port transportation of goods and/or passengers for compensation have been included. Intra-port movements have been excluded.

A vessel is classed as being in foreign service when (1) it arrives from a foreign port as last port of call, or departs for a foreign port as first port of call; or (2) cargo is loaded for a foreign port, or unloaded from a foreign port; or (3) the registry of the vessel is other-than-Canadian or British Commonwealth (even though the vessel may have arrived at one Canadian port from another, or departed from one Canadian port for another).

A vessel is classed as being in coasting service when (1) it is of Canadian or British Commonwealth registry; and (2) it arrives at one Canadian port from another, or departs from one Canadian port for another; and (3) it unloads no freight from a foreign port, or loads no freight for a foreign port; or (4) it is of foreign registry, but is granted a waiver to engage in coasting service.

A vessel from a foreign port calling at two Canadian ports with foreign freight for the second port will be in foreign and out coasting at the first port and in foreign at the second port. Also, a vessel calling at two Canadian ports on a voyage to a foreign port and having loaded freight at the first port for a foreign port is out foreign at the first port and in coasting and out foreign at the second port.

A vessel calling at several Canadian ports with final destination a foreign port is in coasting service into each port. It also is in coasting service out of each port, except the last unless freight for a foreign port is loaded. Because of the variety that is possible in vessel movements, the number of arrivals and departures in either international seaborne shipping or coastwise shipping will not always be the same.

Beginning the count of vessel arrivals and departures on January 1 and ending it on December 31 also causes a disparity in the number of arrivals and departures. Those vessels which arrive in December and depart in January of the next year will be counted only as departures in the statistics of the year in which they depart. Similarly, those vessels which arrive in December and depart in January of the next year will be counted only as arrivals in the statistics of the year in which they arrive.

If a vessel does not unload any freight, or does not load any freight, it is classed as arriving or departing, respectively, "in ballast", regardless of the amount of cargo it might have on board.

Appendix A is a list of the Canadian ports for which shipping data are tabulated separately. This list is derived from the names assigned to the areas of loading or unloading by the respondents. Because of space limitations, data for the complete list of ports is not published in either Part II or Part III of the *Shipping Report*. Those ports for which data are not published separately are designated in the appendix. Information on these ports can be obtained by forwarding a request to the Chief, Transportation Section, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa.

Appendix B is the list of commodities into which all cargoes which are loaded or unloaded at Canadian ports are grouped. This list is based on the *Standard Commodity Classification Manual* published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

Because of space limitations, the description of the commodities which are listed in the tables are often abbreviated or incomplete. Reference to Appendix B, however, will enable users to obtain the complete description.

Also because of space limitations, the headings in the list of commodities have been excluded from the tables. The commodities, however, are listed in the tables in the same order as they appear in Appendix B.

The term "general cargo" which appears in the list of commodities refers to only those commodities which are not identified in the "Shipping Reports" as specific commodities. The term is not intended to indicate the distinction between bulk and other commodities.

The letters "n.e.s." which are found in the commodity listing mean "not elsewhere specified".

It should be noted that, because of corrections made throughout the year, the figures contained in this publication will differ from those released as preliminary data in the monthly *Shipping Report*.

Because of shrinkage and other reasons, loading and unloading figures for a particular commodity do not always agree. For statistical purposes, however, they are required to be the same.

ANALYSIS OF DATA

In 1964 there were significant changes in several of the statistics which measure international seaborne shipping activity at Canadian ports:

Shipments of iron ore from Sept-Îles and Port Cartier continued to expand in 1964 with each port reporting record tonnages. Sept-Îles loaded 31.6 per cent more iron ore in 1964 than the previous year, raising the total to 15,637,818 tons from 11,878,842 tons. Port Cartier iron ore loadings expanded 42.5 per cent, to 10,137,504 tons from 7,112,380 tons. The growing use of pelletized ore was an important factor in the increases registered at these ports.

Grain movements in general, and wheat in particular, affected total tonnage figures for several ports:

Baie Comeau recorded an increase of 575,094 tons in total tonnage handled, to a total of 5,503,454 tons. Wheat movements were largest in volume, with a total of 2,596,505 tons reported which was 473,767 tons more than the 1963 figure of 2,122,738 tons. Corn unloaded from U.S. Great Lakes ports for trans-shipment overseas amounted to 706,041 tons or 1,565 tons more than the previous year's total of 704,476 tons.

Canadian and American grains for trans-shipment overseas comprised over one half of the loadings and unloadings at Trois-Rivières in 1964. Corn and wheat for export increased this year to 484,846 tons, and 865,327 tons, respectively. Unloadings of these grains, however, showed decreases from 1963. Tonnage handled in international seaborne shipping at this port in 1964 surpassed the 1963 figure of 2,872,220 tons, reaching a total of 2,965,983 tons.

Montreal expanded its total tonnage handled in international seaborne shipping by 418,408 tons, to 11,979,876 tons. Sales of wheat to Russia resulted in an increase of 308,105 tons in wheat handled to a total of 2,870,741 tons. The tonnage of barley, corn, oats, and rye handled, however, was down from the previous year, with barley registering the greatest decrease, of 73,836 tons.

The Atlantic Coast ports of Halifax and Saint John moved in opposite directions with respect to the tonnage of wheat handled in 1964. Halifax increased its portion of exports of this commodity by

Some ports are heavily engaged in "lightering". In cases where cargo was loaded or unloaded in a port, but in the harbour rather than at a dock or wharf, the cargo is included with the port totals. Where transshipments were made outside a harbour, or at mid-stream, the cargo handled is treated as a loading or unloading at the nearest port. The ports which have lightered commodities included in their totals are: Botwood, Goose Bay, Charlottetown, Bathurst, Campbellton, Chatham, Rimouski, Chicoutimi, Cacouna, Trois-Rivières, Varennes, and Port Stanley.

127,748 tons, to 555,933 tons, while Saint John handled 29,364 tons less than in 1963. Overall tonnage loaded for, and unloaded from, foreign countries at each of these ports, however, increased appreciably.

In 1964, Port Alfred and Kitimat reported larger tonnages of aluminum ores and concentrates unloaded. The former recorded an increase of 360,097 tons, to 1,818,748 tons, and the latter, 83,502 tons, to 406,677 tons.

Foreign loadings of wheat at Sorel advanced 81.2 per cent, to 862,477 tons from 476,099 tons. Pig iron for export also recorded a sizeable increase, rising by 171,595 tons, to a total of 355,549 tons. A factor in the expanded total of handlings at Sorel was made by unloadings of anthracite coal, which rose by 90,592 tons, to a total of 150,971 tons. The 1964 total of 1,986,968 tons of cargo handled at the port was second only to the 1961 record of 2,088,853 tons.

Several Pacific Coast ports made impressive gains in tonnage handled in international seaborne shipping.

Vancouver remained in first place with 11,589,340 tons moving over its docks, or 15.6 per cent more than the previous year's total of 10,026,420 tons. Wheat shipments for Asian markets advanced by 340,396 tons, to 4,339,663 tons, while barley rose appreciably, to 632,294 tons from 213,032 tons, reported in 1963. Shipments of lumber and timber increased to 1,187,225 tons from 1,093,860 tons, while the increased importance of fertilizer in world markets was evidenced by a rise of 113,673 tons to a total of 440,922 tons.

New Westminster foreign tonnage exceeded 1963 figures by 158,964 tons, reaching a total of 1,389,501 tons. The large quantity of lumber and timber shipped from mills in the vicinity expanded this year by 29,094 tons, to 602,444 tons.

Victoria's exports of wheat and lumber and timber reached totals of 246,527 tons and 607,382 tons, respectively. Loadings of these two commodities comprised 57.2 per cent of the 1,499,280 total tons handled in international seaborne shipping at this port.

Significant changes in the number of vessel arrivals and departures and in the size of their registered net tonnages were recorded at five ports. Two of these ports recorded an increase in activity, while activity at the remainder declined from the previous year.

The number of vessel arrivals and departures at Montreal were up this year, to 5,921, with a registered net tonnage of 23,282,790 tons. During the year prior to the one under review the figures were 5,383 and 21,681,079, respectively.

The second port registering increased activity was Port Arthur-Fort William. The 1,232 vessel arrivals and departures with a registered net tonnage of 7,302,512 tons were considerably greater than the 1963 figures of 1,032 vessels of 5,452,390 registered tons.

The three ports recording declines follow in descending order of size: Vancouver reported 7,152 vessel arrivals and departures with a registered net tonnage of 19,807,028 tons; Toronto reported 2,755 vessels of 8,512,118 registered net tons; and Victoria reported 5,174 vessels of 12,911,022 registered net tons. The corresponding number of arrivals and departures and the registered net tonnages for 1963 were: Vancouver, 7,478 and 20,284,849; Toronto, 3,072 and 8,377,306; and Victoria 5,375 and 13,648,341.
