

INTRODUCTION

Parts I and II of the 1960 "Shipping Report", which have been released previously, contain details of international seaborne shipping, whereas Part III presents data on Canada's coastwise shipping. Statistics relating to shipping on Canada's inland lakes and rivers, such as Lake Winnipeg, the Muskoka Lakes and the MacKenzie River, are not available.

Details of cargoes carried in coastwise shipping have been collected since 1952, but, until 1956, the data pertained only to customs ports. Commencing with the year 1957 the field was expanded to include data for non-customs ports.

During 1960 cargoes unloaded at Canadian ports in coastwise shipping increased 2.7 per cent to 40,777,135 tons from 39,698,650 in 1959. Ports on the Pacific coast again recorded the greatest increase with unloadings up 30 per cent to 10,412,760 tons from 7,988,258. In 1959 the increase at Pacific coast ports was 16.3 per cent. Unloadings at ports on the Atlantic and lower St. Lawrence River were up 3.6 per cent to 18,044,105 tons from 17,413,584, while ports in the Great Lakes area recorded a decrease of 13.8 per cent to 12,320,270 tons from 14,296,808.

Commodities unloaded in greatest volume in coastwise shipping were as follows (1959 data in brackets): pulpwood and chips, 6,753,552 tons (5,378,403); wheat, 6,321,010 tons (7,350,947); petroleum oils, 5,692,736 tons (5,140,115); logs, posts, poles, 2,799,090 tons (1,789,318); gasoline, 2,519,513 tons (2,312,363); general cargo, 2,319,354 tons (2,152,364); sand, gravel and stone, 2,238,004 tons (2,138,232); bituminous coal, 1,869,274 tons (2,341,081); limestone, 1,790,236 tons (942,929); iron ore, 1,685,247 tons (3,303,397); ilmenite ore, 1,002,712 tons (671,060); and barley 922,813 tons (968,395). Compared with the previous year, coastwise shipments of iron ore were down by 1,618,150 tons or 49 per cent, wheat was down 1,029,937 tons or 14 per cent and bituminous coal, 471,807 tons or 20 per cent. These declines, however, were offset by increases of 1,375,149 tons of pulpwood, 1,009,772 tons of logs, 847,307 tons of limestone and 552,621 tons of petroleum oils.

Of the cargo unloaded in coastwise shipping, 34,982,600 tons or 85.8 per cent of the total was transported in vessels of Canadian registry. A total

of 3,682,921 tons or 9 per cent was carried in vessels of United Kingdom registry while vessels of Bahamas and Bermuda registries carried 2,048,143 tons or 5 per cent of the total. Less than one per cent was carried in vessels of other foreign registry.

During the year, vessel arrivals in coastwise service numbered 120,125 with an aggregate registered net tonnage of 88,493,116, compared with 110,702 vessels of 85,536,408 net tons in 1959, an increase of 8.5 per cent in vessels and 3.5 per cent in tonnage. Departures numbered 118,852 with a registered net tonnage of 85,279,786 compared with 109,358 vessels of 82,359,631 net tons in 1959, an increase of 8.7 per cent in vessels and 3.5 per cent in registered net tons. Of total arrivals 57,407, or 47.8 per cent arrived with cargo while the remainder, 62,718, arrived in ballast. Of the departures, 47,690 or 40.1 per cent cleared with cargo. For the purpose of these statistics a vessel which does not unload or load any cargo is classed as arriving or departing "in ballast", regardless of the amount of cargo on board.

Canadian ports handling the greatest volume of freight in coastwise shipping were: Montreal, 8,219,516 tons (8,650,035 tons in 1959); Vancouver, 6,154,051 tons (5,263,973); Port Arthur, 5,242,152 tons (5,585,836); Fort William 2,821,263 tons (2,948,994); Sydney 2,800,239 tons (2,999,962); Quebec, 2,598,830 tons (2,668,162); New Westminster 2,446,903 tons (1,691,367); Sarnia 2,177,151 tons (2,303,072); Toronto, 2,171,970 tons (2,340,679); Halifax 1,970,882 tons (1,807,491); Trois Rivières 1,758,953 tons (1,705,886); and Sorel 1,549,088 tons (1,544,075). These ports accounted for 49 per cent of all freight loaded and unloaded in coastwise shipping.

Ports showing the largest increases in coastwise traffic were Vancouver and New Westminster, followed by Saint John which was up 558,365 tons to 1,108,359; Colborne, up 557,137 tons to 847,229 and Clarkson up 476,778 tons to 1,192,884. The largest decreases were recorded at Sept Iles, down 1.6 million tons to 956,397 from 2,516,891 in 1959, Hamilton, down 1.1 million to 917,392 tons from 2,027,262, and Port Colborne down 1 million tons to 1,190,148 tons from 2,215,816.


