

INTRODUCTION

This part of the annual "Shipping Report" provides origin and destination details of eight selected commodities which are loaded and unloaded at Canadian ports. These commodities are wheat, other grain, pulpwood, iron ore, bituminous coal, gypsum, newsprint, and fuel oil.

In some instances the tonnages reported at the port of loading do not correspond exactly with the tonnages reported at the port of unloading. This is

due mainly to changes en route which were not reported, and to inaccuracies in reporting. These inconsistencies, which are of minor significance, are expected to diminish as tracing procedures are improved.

For the purpose of this publication, the statistics for iron ore include ilmenite ore, and the terms "origin" and "destination" refer only to the ports of loading and unloading.

REVIEW OF 1962 OPERATIONS

The eight selected commodities accounted for 66 per cent of all cargo loaded and unloaded in international seaborne shipping, and 59 per cent of all coastwise traffic. International seaborne shipments of these commodities increased 12 per cent, while coastwise movements decreased 13 per cent, compared to 1961 figures. Total cargo handled in 1962 showed a 10 per cent increase in foreign shipping, and a decrease of 6 per cent in coastwise traffic.

Because Canada has a comparative advantage in the production of wheat, pulpwood, gypsum, and newsprint, waterborne shipments of these four commodities formed the bulk of cargoes loaded for foreign countries in 1962. Unloadings of bituminous coal and fuel oil amounted to substantially more than half of the total unloadings of the selected commodities in international seaborne shipping. Shipments of iron ore and other grain were signifi-

cant in both loadings for foreign countries and unloadings from foreign countries.

The statistics for iron ore and gypsum represent almost all of the international seaborne shipping activity at the ports of Bell Island, Nfld.; Hantsport, N.S.; and Sept Iles, P.Q. The two commodities loaded at these ports for foreign countries totalled 14,600,000 tons, or 14 per cent of all cargo handled in foreign shipping at Canadian ports, and 98 per cent of all cargo handled in foreign shipping at the three ports.

A total of 102,200,000 tons of cargo was handled at Canadian ports in international seaborne shipping, compared with 93,000,000 tons in 1961. The eight selected commodities accounted for 74 per cent of all loadings, and 55 per cent of all unloadings in international seaborne shipping, as shown in the following table:

Loadings for Foreign Countries

In 1962 cargo loaded at Canadian ports for foreign countries totalled 60,300,000 tons. The eight selected commodities accounted for 74 per cent of this amount, or 44,600,000 tons, compared to 73 per cent, or 39,100,000 tons, in 1961.

Of the 44,600,000 tons, iron ore accounted for 54 per cent, or 24,300,000 tons. This was a 42 per cent increase over iron ore loadings in 1961. Loadings of iron ore at Quebec ports totalled 17,200,000 tons, with 14,700,000 tons destined for United States ports and 2,500,000 tons destined for the United Kingdom and Europe. Ontario ports shipped 4,300,000 tons of iron ore, almost all of which was destined for United States ports. The amount of iron ore loaded at Newfoundland ports decreased to 994,000 tons from 2,300,000 tons. Ninety-nine per cent of this iron ore was transported to the United Kingdom and Europe. British Columbia loaded 1,700,000 tons of iron ore, which was shipped to Japan.

Although the tonnage of wheat shipments to foreign countries dropped by 17 per cent, wheat was second in volume loaded. Thirty-nine per cent of the nearly 9,000,000 tons of wheat loaded at Canadian ports for foreign countries was destined for Asia. Thirty-one per cent of the wheat was destined for Europe, and 24 per cent was destined for the United Kingdom. Forty-four per cent of the wheat was loaded in British Columbia, and 39 per cent was shipped from Quebec. In 1961, 37 per cent of the wheat was loaded in British Columbia, and 44 per cent in Quebec.

Pulpwood loaded for foreign countries totalled 1,830,000 tons, compared with 1,750,000 tons in 1961. Approximately 1,200,000 tons of pulpwood was shipped to United States ports. More than half of the total pulpwood loaded was from ports in British Columbia.

Foreign shipments of gypsum totalled 4,100,000 tons, compared with 3,900,000 tons in 1961. Shipments of newsprint were down slightly, to 2,895,000 tons from 2,922,000 tons in 1961. Loadings of other grain and bituminous coal decreased to 1,700,000 tons and 628,000 tons from 1,800,000 tons and 709,000 tons, respectively. Fuel oil shipments increased to 194,000 tons from 115,000 tons in 1961.

Unloadings from Foreign Countries

Cargoes unloaded from foreign countries totalled 41,900,000 tons. The eight selected commodities accounted for 55 per cent, or 22,800,000

tons of this total, compared to 54 per cent, or 21,200,000 tons, in 1961.

Unloadings of bituminous coal accounted for 48 per cent, or 10,900,000 tons, of the tonnage attributable to the selected commodities. Unloadings of bituminous coal in 1962 were 2.1 per cent greater than in 1961. Ninety-four per cent of the bituminous coal which originated at United States Great Lakes ports was destined for Ontario. Shipments of iron ore unloaded totalled 5,800,000 tons, compared to 5,400,000 tons in 1961. Eighty-six per cent of the iron ore was loaded at United States Great Lakes ports for Canadian Great Lakes ports. Thirteen per cent of the iron ore originated in South America.

Fuel oil unloaded at Canadian ports from foreign countries rose to 3,700,000 tons from 3,200,000 tons in 1961. Fifty-seven per cent of it came from the Netherlands Antilles, and 30 per cent from South America. Quebec was the destination of 55 per cent of the total amount of fuel oil unloaded. Nova Scotia received 17 per cent of the fuel oil, and the remaining 28 per cent was unloaded at ports in other provinces and the Northwest Territories.

Shipments of other grain increased to 1,800,000 tons from 1,300,000 tons in 1961. This was directly attributable to increased shipments of barley and corn from United States ports. Sixty-eight per cent of the other grain was unloaded at Quebec ports, and 30 per cent at Ontario ports.

Coastwise Shipping

In coastwise waterborne traffic the selected commodities accounted for 28,600,000 tons, or 59 per cent of the total cargoes unloaded, compared to 29,500,000 tons, or 64 per cent, in 1961. Unloadings of pulpwood, wheat, and fuel oil accounted for 76 per cent of the total movement of the selected commodities.

Total unloadings included 6,620,000 tons of pulpwood, of which more than half, or 3,550,000 tons, was unloaded at British Columbia ports from other British Columbia ports. Twenty-six per cent of the pulpwood was unloaded at Quebec ports.

Coastal wheat shipments totalled 6,590,000 tons, which represented a decrease of 26 per cent compared to 1961. Fifty-six per cent of the wheat was unloaded in Quebec, and 41 per cent in Ontario.

Shipments of fuel oil amounted to 6,310,000 tons, which was up slightly from the 6,232,000 tons recorded in 1961. Thirty-eight per cent of the fuel oil was unloaded at Ontario ports, and 24 per cent at Quebec ports.


