INTRODUCTION

This part of the "Shipping Report" provides information on the origin and destination of eight selected commodities. These commodities are wheat, other grain, pulpwood, iron ore, bituminous coal, gypsum, newsprint, and fuel oil. Corresponding information for all other commodities can be tabulated upon request. Such requests should be forwarded to the Chief, Transportation Section, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa. When these requests require a special tabulation, it is customary to charge for the machine and labour time, at cost.

Because Canada has a comparative advantage in the production of wheat, pulpwood, gypsum, and newsprint, waterborne shipments of these four commodities form the bulk of cargoes loaded for foreign countries. Bituminous coal and fuel oil are the important commodities unloaded in international seaborne shipping. Shipments of iron ore and other grain are significant in both loadings for foreign countries and unloadings from foreign countries.

Source

Only data relating to those vessels which are engaged in port-to-port transportation of goods and/or passengers for compensation have been included. Intra-port movements have been excluded.

Shipping operating statistics are compiled from reports made by operators or agents of vessels which arrive at, and depart from, Canadian ports. With the exception of vessels of less than fifteen registered net tons, naval vessels, and fishing vessels, all vessels are required to complete "Shipping Reports". At ports where there are customs officers these officials act as agents for the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in collecting the reports and forwarding them to the Bureau. The reports which record the activity at non-customs ports are forwarded through the nearest customs office.

The co-operation of shipping operators and agents in completing "Shipping Reports", and the Customs and Excise Division of the National Revenue Department in collecting these reports, has continued to be excellent.

Treatment of Data

A vessel is classed as being in foreign service when (1) it arrives from a foreign port as last port of call, or departs for a foreign port as first port of call; or (2) cargo is loaded for a foreign port, or unloaded from a foreign port; or (3) the registry of the vessel is other-than-Canadian or British Commonwealth (even though the vessel may have arrived at one Canadian port from another, or departed from one Canadian port for another).

A vessel is classed as being in coasting service when (1) it is of Canadian or British Commonwealth registry; and (2) it arrives at one Canadian port from another, or departs from one Canadian port for another; and (3) it unloads no freight from a foreign port, or loads no freight for a foreign port; or (4) it is of foreign registry, but is granted a waiver to engage in coasting service.

A vessel from a foreign port calling at two Canadian ports with foreign freight for the second port will be in foreign and out coasting at the first port and in foreign at the second port. Also, a vessel calling at two Canadian ports on a voyage to a foreign port and having loaded freight at the first port for a foreign port is out foreign at the first port and in coasting and out foreign at the second port. A vessel calling at several Canadian ports with final destination a foreign port is in coasting service into each port. It also is in coasting service out of each port except the last port, unless freight for a foreign port is loaded.

For the purpose of this publication, the statistics for iron ore include ilmenite ore, and the terms "origin" and "destination" refer only to the ports of loading and unloading. The term "other grain" refers to barley, corn, oats, and rye.

To facilitate the proper interpretation of the data contained in Table 29 of this publication, the following should be noted: the last two columns of the table show the tonnage of cargo loaded or unloaded at the ports listed in the second column; the third column should be read as the ORIGIN of the tonnage shown in the fifth column and as the DESTINATION of the tonnage shown in the fourth column.

Because of shrinkage and other reasons, loading and unloading figures do not always agree. For statistical purposes, however, they are required to be the same.

To provide more information, data for thirty-eight ports or areas in the United States have been presented separately this year. In former years these ports were combined into "U.S. Pacific, Great Lakes, and Atlantic and Gulf Ports".

Appendix A is a list of the countries and geographic areas of origin or destination of the commodities which are loaded and unloaded at Canadian ports in international seaborne shipping. These countries have been divided into Commonwealth countries and other countries.

ANALYSIS OF DATA

In descending order of size, the following tonnages of the eight commodities were handled in 1964: iron ore, 46,219,545 tons (36,932,141 tons in 1963); wheat, 38,214,050 tons (30,442,661 tons); fuel oil, 20,232,107 tons (16,986,147 tons); pulpwood, 16,468,950 tons (14,316,088 tons); bituminous coal, 16,428,114 tons (17,208,220 tons); other grain, 7,912,554 tons (8,482,705 tons); gypsum, 5,859,723 tons (5,649,298 tons); and newsprint, 4,111,219 tons (3,581,988 tons).

Loadings for Foreign Countries

Cargo loaded at Canadian ports for shipment abroad during 1964 amounted to 83,510,707 tons. The eight selected commodities accounted for 75.7 per cent of this total.

Iron ore shipments for foreign countries reached a new peak this year, when 34,380,976 tons were transported by water, compared to 26,063,195 tons in 1963. Quebec ports loaded 26,185,360 tons of this commodity, for an increase of 34.7 per cent over 1963. The United States remained the main recipient of the Quebec loadings, with Philadelphia and Baltimore receiving the largest amounts of 5,292,269 and 3,363,109 tons, respectively. Overseas shipments to the United Kingdom from Sept Iles totalled 3,306,549 tons, which was considerably more than the 1963 total of 2,441,035 tons.

Ontario ports loaded 5,300,875 tons of iron ore during 1964, exceeding the 4,292,308 tons moved in 1963 by 23.5 per cent. All of this ore was exported to U.S. Great Lakes ports. The twin cities of Port Arthur-Fort William contributed 3,133,229 tons of the total Ontario loadings.

Bell Island, Newfoundland increased its exports of iron ore to the United Kingdom and other European countries to 956,884 tons from 678,277 tons, for an increase of 41.1 per cent. On the West Coast, Toquart and Texada increased shipments to Japan, rising this year to 763,000 and 492,955 tons, respectively.

The second largest commodity loaded in 1964 was wheat. Shipments of this commodity increased 17.9 per cent, to 14,513,782 tons from 12,308,281 tons in 1963. This was the second consecutive year that loadings of wheat for foreign countries recorded an increase. The major export ports for this commodity were: Vancouver, 4,339,663 tons; Montreal, 2,795,166 tons; and Baie Comeau, 2,284,253 tons. Exports of wheat to the U.S.S.R. totalled an unprecedented 3,252,790 tons, while wheat shipments destined for United Kingdom and Communist China ports amounted to 2,241,891 and 1,705,964 tons, respectively.

Gypsum accounted for the third largest tonnage, increasing by 7.8 per cent, to 4,936,776 tons from 4,581,484 tons. All shipments were from the Atlantic provinces of Newfoundland and Nova Scotia, and all but 23,201 tons were destined for United States Atlantic and Gulf ports. The other area receiving shipments of this commodity was the Bahamas.

Other selected commodities in order of tonnage loaded were:

Newsprint: 3,280,498 tons, up 12.0 per cent over the 1963 total of 2,929,590 tons. Shipments to the United States of 2,189,686 tons and the United Kingdom of 509,583 tons, amounted to 82.3 per cent of the total.

Other grain: 2,973,458 tons, an increase of 7.2 per cent from the 2,773,408 tons reported in the previous year. A considerable portion of the total loadings of other grain consisted of U.S. grain which was trans-shipped at Canadian ports for overseas countries. The United Kingdom and Other European countries absorbed 74.6 per cent of the total.

Pulpwood: 2,136,301 tons, up 3.2 per cent over 1963. British Columbia ports exported 1,066,191 tons of this commodity to U.S. West Coast ports, while on the East Coast, Newcastle, New Brunswick was the port of origin for 92,709 tons destined for various European countries.

Bituminous coal: 855,950 tons, up 14.2 per cent over 1963. Of the total amount loaded at all Canadian ports, Vancouver had the largest portion—575,612 tons, nearly all of which was shipped to Japan.

Fuel oil: 159,567 tons, down 29.3 per cent from 1963. Approximately two-thirds (68.1 per cent) was destined for U.S. Great Lakes and Atlantic and Gulf ports.

Unloadings from Foreign Countries

Cargo unloaded from foreign countries totalled 47,578,260 tons. The eight selected commodities accounted for 27,484,796 tons, or 57.8 per cent of the total, which was a slight decline from 1963, when the same eight commodities shared 59 per cent of the total.

Once again, bituminous coal was unloaded in greatest volume, with 13,610,132 tons reported. The total was 1.2 per cent higher than in 1963, primarily because of increased industrial activity at Canadian Great Lakes ports. Four of the larger ports of destination were: Hamilton, 3,177,688 tons; Sault Ste. Marie, 2,289,404 tons; Toronto, 2,084,456 tons; and Port Credit 1,349,031 tons.

The next most important commodity unloaded in 1964 was iron ore. This year 6,078,727 tons or 6.6 per cent less than in 1963 were discharged at Canadian ports. Most of the iron ore movement took place on the Great Lakes, originating at U.S. ports and destined for: Hamilton, 4,061,760 tons; Sault Ste. Marie, 1,006,512 tons; and Port Colborne, 228,171 tons. Brazilian ore was unloaded at Sydney,

Contrecoeur, and Montreal in slightly smaller amounts than in 1963.

Fuel oil was the third largest tonnage unloaded from abroad in 1964. Of the 5,073,872 tons discharged, 48.4 per cent originated in the Netherlands Antilles and 31.4 per cent in Venezuela. Montreal, Quebec, and Halifax unloaded 1,474,739 tons, 569,270 tons, and 422,277 tons, respectively, accounting for 48.6 per cent of total unloadings of fuel oil during the year.

Coastwise Shipping

The eight selected commodities accounted for 62.4 per cent of the 51,864,783 tons of coastwise cargo unloaded at Canadian ports in 1964.

Unloadings of wheat, the largest commodity in terms of tonnage handled, rose 34.5 per cent, to 11,579,257 tons during 1964, primarily as a result of Canada's international wheat sales. Several ports concerned with the trans-shipment of this commodity handled larger tonnages than the previous year. Quebec ports absorbed 7,995,912 tons of shipments from the Great Lakes area—Bale Comeau and Montreal shared 5,513,624 tons of the total, with the balance distributed among Trois-Rivières, Sorel, and Quebec. Ontario ports reported unloadings of 3,207,716 tons.

Fuel oil remained in second place with 7,499,334 tons unloaded, which was an increase of 14.9 per cent from the previous year. The provinces of Ontario and Quebec continued to be the areas in which the larger unloadings took place, with Quebec City, Hamilton and Toronto reporting unloadings of 496,487 tons, 302,794 tons and 279,099 tons, respectively. The largest loadings were at Montreal, 2,305,283 tons; Sarnia, 1,268,706 and Halifax 1,307,802 tons.

Third in tonnage unloaded during 1964 was pulpwood, with a total of 7,155,831 tons. This was an increase of 16.9 per cent over the previous twelve-month period. British Columbia ports accounted for 4,226,577 tons, or 59 per cent of the total. Ports reporting the largest loadings were: Vancouver, 1,904,909 tons; New Westminster, 725,877 tons; and Forestville, Quebec, 898,272 tons.

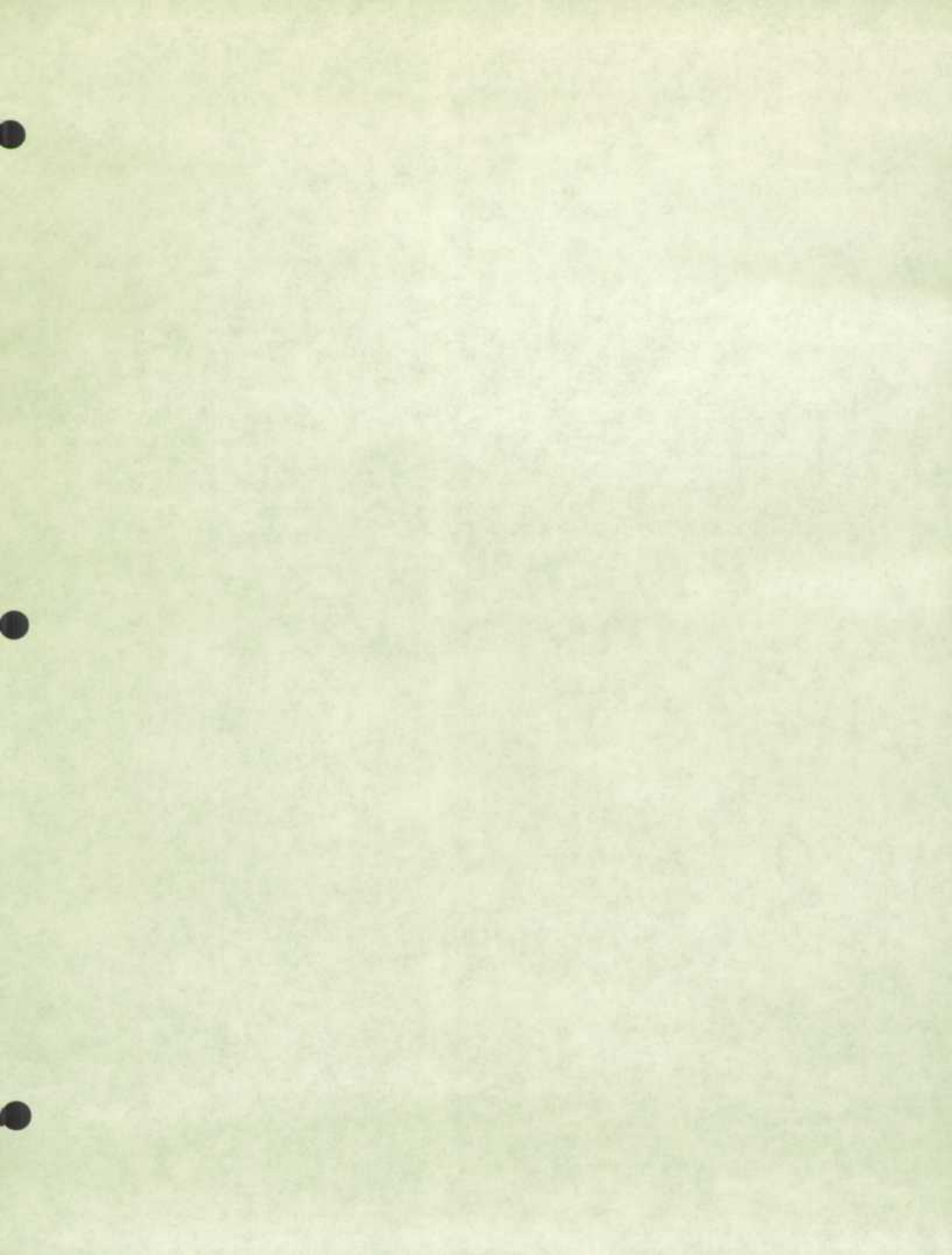
