INTRODUCTION

This part of the "Shipping Report" provides information on the origin and destination of eight selected commodities. These commodities are wheat, other grain, pulpwood, iron ore, bituminous coal, gypsum, newsprint, and fuel oil. Corresponding information for all other commodities can be tabulated upon request. Such requests should be forwarded to the Chief, Transportation and Public Utilities Section, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa. When these requests require a special tabulation, it is customary to charge for the machine and labour time, at cost.

Because Canada has a comparative advantage in the production of wheat, pulpwood, gypsum, and newsprint, waterborne shipments of these four commodities form the bulk of cargoes loaded for foreign countries. Bituminous coal and fuel oil are the important commodities unloaded in international seaborne shipping. Shipments of iron ore and other grain are significant in both loadings for foreign countries and unloadings from foreign countries.

Source

Only data relating to those vessels which are engaged in port-to-port transportation of goods and/or passengers for compensation have been included. Intra-port movements have been excluded.

Shipping operating statistics are compiled from reports made by operators or agents of vessels which arrive at, and depart from, Canadian ports. With the exception of vessels of less than fifteen registered net tons, naval vessels, and fishing vessels, all vessels are required to complete "Shipping Reports". At ports where there are customs officers these officials act as agents for the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in collecting the reports and forwarding them to the Bureau. The reports which record the activity at non-customs ports are forwarded through the nearest customs office.

The co-operation of shipping operators and agents in completing "Shipping Reports", and the Customs and Excise Division of the National Revenue Department in collecting these reports, has continued to be excellent.

Treatment of Data

A vessel is classed as being in foreign service when (1) it arrives from a foreign port as last port of call, or departs for a foreign port as first port of call; or (2) cargo is loaded for a foreign port, or unloaded from a foreign port; or (3) the registry of the vessel is other-than-Canadian or British Commonwealth (even though the vessel may have arrived at one Canadian port from another, or departed from one Canadian port for another).

A vessel is classed as being in coasting service when (1) it is of Canadian or British Commonwealth registry; and (2) it arrives at one Canadian port from another, or departs from one Canadian port for another; and (3) it unloads no freight from a foreign port, or loads no freight for a foreign port; or (4) it is of foreign registry, but is granted a waiver to engage in coasting service.

A vessel from a foreign port calling at two Canadian ports with foreign freight for the second port will be in foreign and out coasting at the first port and in foreign at the second port. Also, a vessel calling at two Canadian ports on a voyage to a foreign port and having loaded freight at the first port for a foreign port is out foreign at the first port and in coasting and out foreign at the second port. A vessel calling at several Canadian ports with final destination a foreign port is in coasting service into each port. It also is in coasting service out of each port except the last port, unless freight for a foreign port is loaded.

For the purpose of this publication, the statistics for iron ore include ilmenite ore, and the terms "origin" and "destination" refer only to the ports of loading and unloading. The term "other grain" refers to barley, corn, oats, and rye.

To facilitate the proper interpretation of the data contained in Table 29 of this publication, the following should be noted: the last two columns of the table show the tonnage of cargo loaded or unloaded at the ports listed in the second column; the third column should be read as the ORIGIN of the tonnage shown in the fifth column and as the DESTINATION of the tonnage shown in the fourth column.

Because of shrinkage and other reasons, loading and unloading figures do not always agree. For statistical purposes, however, they are required to be the same.

To provide more information, data for thirty-eight ports or areas in the United States have been presented separately this year. In former years these ports were combined into "U.S. Pacific, Great Lakes, and Atlantic and Gulf Ports".

Appendix A is a list of the countries and geographic areas of origin or destination of the commodities which are loaded and unloaded at Canadian ports in international seaborne shipping. These countries have been divided into Commonwealth countries and other countries.

ANALYSIS OF DATA

The eight selected commodities accounted for 68.0 per cent of all cargo handled in international seaborne shipping at Canadian ports in 1965 and 58.2 per cent of all coastwise unloadings. In the previous year these percentages were 69.2 and 62.4 respectively.

Loadings for Foreign Countries

Cargo shipped from Canadian ports to other countries during 1965 amounted to 82,145,421 tons, of which total the eight selected commodities accounted for 61,120,926 tons or 74.4 per cent.

Iron ore again made up the largest single commodity tonnage; 33,460,919 tons were exported by water in 1965, down 920,057 tons from the peak recorded in the previous year when 34,380,976 tons were loaded for other countries. Quebec ports loaded 25,913,044 tons or 77.4 per cent of all Canadian shipments; during 1964 Quebec ports accounted for 26,185,360 tons. The United States received the bulk of these loadings with Philadelphia, Baltimore, Detroit and Cleveland receiving the greatest shares.

Ports in Ontario shipped 4,439,447 tons of iron ore during 1965, down 861,428 tons or 16.3 per cent compared to the previous year. Port Arthur-Fort William loaded 2,433,965 tons which was 699,264 tons lower than during 1964; all of this ore was shipped to United States Great Lakes ports. Bell Island, Newfoundland exported 1,152,306 tons of this commodity in 1965 and 956,884 tons in 1964; Belgium and Luxembourg received 602,668 tons, up 281,481 tons, while the United Kingdom received 190,049 tons, down 129,118 tons. On the West Coast shipments totalled 1,956,105 tons which represents an increase of 18,248 tons over 1964; Japan was the recipient of almost all of this tonnage.

Wheat was second in terms of tonnage loaded during 1965; exports declined 7.3 per cent to 13,457,870 tons from 14,513,782 tons during 1964. The major ports involved in the movements of this commodity to other countries were; Vancouver, 3,688,822 tons (4,339,663 tons in 1964); Montreal; 2,429,691 tons (2,795,166 tons); and Baie Comeau, 2,214,086 tons (2,284,253 tons). The U.S.S.R. absorbed 3,096,092 tons (3,252,790 tons in 1964), the United Kingdom 2,227,700 tons (2,241,891 tons), Communist China 1,733,021 tons (1,705,964 tons), and Japan 1,308,210 tons (1,445,612 tons).

Gypsum shipments were third largest during the year; exports totalling 4,852,978 tons, declined by only 83,798 tons. All shipments originated in Newfoundland and Nova Scotia, and all but 30,433 tons were bound for United States Atlantic and Gulf ports.

Other selected commodities in order of tonnage loaded were:

Newsprint: 3,393,739 tons, up 113,241 tons or 3.5 per cent over 1964; the United States and the United Kingdom, receiving 2,370,306 tons and 425,310 tons respectively (82.4 per cent of total) were the chief markets for this commodity.

Other grain: 3,030,068 tons, an increase of 56,610 tons or 1.9 per cent over the previous year; the bulk of this tonnage is destined for the United Kingdom and other European countries.

Pulpwood: 1,828,023 tons, down 308,278 tons or 14.4 per cent from 1964; British Columbia ports loaded only 728,484 tons compared to 1,068,991 tons in 1964, due to lower shipments to United States Pacific ports.

Bituminous coal: 941,230 tons, up 85,280 tons or 10.0 per cent over the previous year. A total of 924,777 tons were loaded at Port Moody and Vancouver for Japan.

Fuel oil: 156,099 tons, down only 3,468 tons from 1964; most of this tonnage was destined for United States Atlantic and Gulf ports and for islands of St. Pierre and Miquelon.

Unloadings from Foreign Countries

At Canadian ports, cargo unloaded from foreign countries totalled 53,644,740 tons. The eight selected commodities accounted for 31,218,655 tons or 58.2 per cent of the 1965 total, compared to 57.8 per cent of 1964 unloadings in international seaborne shipping.

During the year, 15,306,625 tons of bituminous coal were unloaded, representing an increase of 12.5 per cent over the 13,610,132 tons unloaded in 1964. Most of this tonnage was discharged at Ontario ports: Hamilton, unloaded 3,205,618 tons (3,177,688 tons in 1964), Toronto, 2,396,528 tons (2,084,456 tons), and Sault Ste. Marie, 2,267,964 tons (2,289,404 tons).

Fuel oil shipments to Canada rose 47.0 per cent to 7,458,567 tons from 5,073,872 tons during the previous year; 43.7 per cent (48.4 per cent in 1964) originated in the Netherlands Antilles and 37.6 per cent (31.4 per cent) in Venezuela. Three ports—Montreal, Quebec and Halifax, unloading 2,144,661 tons (1,474,739 in 1964), 918,973 tons (569,270 tons), and 668,323 tons (422,277 tons) respectively—accounted for 50.0 per cent (43.6 per cent) of total fuel oil unloadings.

Iron ore unloadings declined 10.6 per cent to 5,434,652 tons from 6,078,727 tons in 1964. Hamilton unloaded 3,855,561 tons of ore in 1965 compared to

4,061,760 tons in the previous year; however, unloadings in coastwise traffic at this port increased appreciably. Port Colborne and Sault Ste. Marie, unloading 225,539 tons and 841,831 tons, were the other receiving centres for American ore.

Coastwise Shipping

During 1965, the eight selected commodities accounted for 30,897,333 tons or 58.2 per cent of the 53,094,252 tons of cargo unloaded at Canadian ports in coastwise traffic; last year these commodities formed 62.4 per cent of coastwise unloadings.

Unloadings of wheat declined 11.2 per cent to 10,283,290 tons from the previous year's record of 11,579,257 tons. Foreign wheat shipments contracted during the year, reducing tonnages unloaded at several St. Lawrence River ports which transfer large volumes of this commodity from laker to elevator to ocean-going vessel. Quebec ports received 5,317,223 tons from the Great Lakes area, compared to 8,002,064 tons in 1964. Of total unloadings, 9,053,799 tons or 88.0 per cent originated in Port Arthur-Fort William; all shipments to points in Quebec were lower. For example wheat from this port to Montreal declined by 289,064 tons to a total of 2,649,453 tons, Baie Comeau, down 222,057 tons to 1,746,201 tons, and Trois-Rivières, down 253,360 tons to 588,836 tons.

Fuel oil unloadings, totalling 7,483,639 tons, were slightly less than last year's record of 7,499,334 tons which represented an increase of 14.9 per cent over 1963. Major receiving centres in Quebec and Ontario for this commodity included Quebec City, Hamilton and Sault Ste. Marie, which unloaded 464,154 tons, 400,499 tons and 324,130 tons re-

spectively. The largest distribution ports were Montreal, with 2,143,463 tons loaded (2,305,283 tons in 1964), Sarnia, 1,363,365 tons (1,268,706 tons) and Halifax, 1,337,459 tons (1,307,802 tons); on the West Coast, Vancouver was the only large loading point, supplying British Columbia ports with 855,491 tons (835,796 tons in 1964) of this commodity.

During the year unloadings of pulpwood amounted to 7,155,371 tons, almost identical to 1964 unloadings of 7,155,831 tons. British Columbia ports accounted for 4,882,760 tons, or 68.2 per cent of all pulpwood unloadings. Pulpwood originating at Vancouver totalled 1,879,067 tons (1,904,909 tons in 1964) and at New Westminster 929,442 tons (725,877 tons); the greater part of this tonnage was destined for Britannia Beach, Crofton, Duncan Bay and Port Mellon. Forrestville was the only significant loading point in the east; 852,188 tons (898,272 tons in 1964) were loaded, almost all for Quebec City.

Iron ore unloaded in coastwise traffic in 1965 amounted to 2,393,654 tons compared to 2,897,921 tons in 1964. However, the ilmenite ore (averaging 37% titanium oxide and 42% iron) loaded at Havre Ste Pierre (1,362,415 tons in 1964) is now published as titanium ore rather than iron ore as in previous years. Hamilton received 1,029,079 tons of ore, up 973,745 tons over the 55,334 tons shown in 1964; significant tonnages originated in Pointe Noire (751,801 tons) and Port Cartier (169,933 tons).


