## INTRODUCTION

This publication presents statistics on the origin and destination of eight commodities which are of the greatest significance in tonnage terms of Canada's annual waterborne traffic. Similar information can be tabulated for other commodities upon request to the Chief, Transportation Section, Dominion Bureau of Statistics, Ottawa; when a special tabulation is required, any charges are calculated for labor and machine time at cost.

### Source

Shipping statistics are compiled from reports completed by operators or agents of vessels arriving and departing Canadian ports. All vessels are required to submit reports except naval or fishing vessels, and craft of less than fifteen registered net tons. Customs officials act as agents for the Dominion Bureau of Statistics in collecting forms at customs ports; returns for non-customs ports are forwarded through the nearest customs office. Operating data are collected for vessels calling at coastal and Great Lakes ports, but regions such as Lake Winnipeg and the MacKenzie River are not included in the survey.

### Treatment of Data

Only data relating to those vessels which are engaged in port-to-port transportation of goods and/or passengers for compensation have been included; all intra-port movements have been excluded.

The term "international seaborne shipping" is used for vessels classed as being in foreign service, that is when (1) the vessel arrives from or departs for a foreign port; (2) cargo is loaded for or unloaded from a foreign port; or (3) the registry of

the vessel is other than Canadian or British Commonwealth (even though the vessel may have sailed between two Canadian ports).

A vessel is classed as being in coasting service if (1) it is of Canadian or British Commonwealth registry, sails between two Canadian ports, and loads or unloads no foreign freight; or if (2) it is of foreign registry, but is granted a waiver to engage in coasting service. On a voyage, a vessel's arrival and departure could easily alternate between foreign or coastwise in view of the variety that is possible in vessel movements.

In this publication, the term "other grain" refers to barley, corn, oats and rye; also, iron ore includes the titanium ore (which has an iron content) mined at Havre St. Pierre.

Because of shrinkage and other reasons, loading and unloading figures for a particular commodity do not always agree; for statistical purposes, however, they are required to be the same.

When using Table 29, the cargo tons loaded refer to the volume shipped from a port in the second column to the destination specified in the third column; an unloading figure reverses these roles to destination and origin respectively.

Appendix A consists of a list of the geographic areas of origin or destination of the commodities which are loaded and unloaded at Canadian ports in international shipping.

It should be noted that due to corrections made throughout the year, statistics contained in this publication may differ from that released as preliminary data in the monthly *Shipping Statistics*.

## ANALYSIS OF DATA

During 1967, the eight commodities in this report made up 65.4 per cent of all foreign trade by weight, as well as 58.6 per cent of domestic shipping. In the previous year, these proportions were 68.4 and 61.4 per cent respectively.

**Wheat**

Lower world demand for wheat was illustrated in the contraction of Canadian shipments by one-third to 10,464,062 tons. The value of this country's domestic wheat exports was over \$740 million.

A reduction of over one million tons to Communist countries, and declines in Indian and European shipments depressed the Montreal total to 1,824,873 tons from 3,407,739 tons in 1966. Similarly, shipments from Baie Comeau were practically halved to 1,204,377 tons, while volume at Sorel and Trois-Rivières also fell sharply. Quebec loadings, however, advanced to 651,364 tons from 548,466 tons in 1966; this year the port received American wheat for later export.

Halifax and Saint John exported 852,992 tons, roughly one-fifth less than 1966 because of diminished Soviet demand. Port Arthur - Fort William registered greater direct overseas exports of wheat, which rose to 383,285 tons from 166,990 tons in 1966. On the Pacific Coast, declines were reported for New Westminster, Prince Rupert, Victoria and Vancouver. The latter port exported 3,495,612 tons in 1967 and 4,246,672 tons in 1966, the loss traceable to mainland China, down over 700,000 to 978,707 tons; Japan became the port's major receiver at 1,242,304 tons.

The export picture for wheat led to reduced coastal transport requirements for movement to overseas shipping points. Consequently, domestic volume slipped to 7,477,763 tons from 12,730,806 tons. Traffic from Port Arthur-Fort William comprised 90.6 per cent of the year's wheat total, most of which was destined for elevators along the St. Lawrence River.

**Other Grain**

Imports of barley, corn, oats and rye dropped to 1,212,539 tons from 1,831,530 tons in 1966, while shipments abroad slid to 1,911,553 tons from 2,231,430 tons.

Foreign loadings from Baie Comeau, Montreal, and Trois-Rivières were much lower, having fallen to 488,751 tons from 1.2 million in the previous year; unloadings from the United States at 548,138 tons, were also considerably reduced. Europe, led by the United Kingdom, continued as the major receiver of these grains from the three ports.

Quebec City reported a larger grain intake from the United States (to 297,230 tons from 66,027 tons in 1966), while exports jumped to 266,624 tons from 40,304 tons. Port Arthur-Fort William shipped more overseas and less to the United States; the total advanced to 504,539 tons from 364,633 tons in 1966. Vancouver's trade in these grains moved to 642,032 tons from 559,483 tons, the increase being attributable to Japanese purchases, which offset declines for Germany and the Netherlands.

Domestic traffic in these commodities rose to 1,944,578 tons from 1,646,341 tons in 1966. Port Arthur-Fort William accounted for practically all of this traffic and over one half of its 1,909,473 tons were destined for Montreal, Quebec, Baie Comeau and Trois-Rivières.

**Pulpwood**

Canadian exports of pulpwood dropped to 1,615,240 tons from 1,782,764 tons in 1966, despite a 230,000 ton betterment for the West Coast. The year's exports were valued in excess of \$38 million.

British Columbia traffic with the United States was slightly under a million tons in 1967, Vancouver leading at 490,080 tons. Western Europe receipts of pulpwood were almost halved,

at 427,132 tons from the Maritimes and Quebec. The eastern United States was the destination of 195,409 tons, down almost 60,000 from 1966. Although appreciably lower, Baie Comeau was the major eastern shipping point, at 75,764 tons, being followed by Port Arthur-Fort William at 71,840 tons.

In domestic shipping pulpwood fell back by approximately 15 per cent to 7,094,899 tons, or near the levels experienced in 1965 and 1964. Vancouver shipped 2,524,546 tons during the year, large tonnages directed to Nanaimo, Campbell River, Britannia Beach, and Crofton; in 1966 2,383,750 tons were reported. New Westminster shipped 1,016,658 tons, roughly 80,000 below 1966. In the east, most of the traffic is received at Quebec (823,750 tons), Trois-Rivières (503,918 tons) and Port Alfred (260,328 tons); Forrestville at 704,008 tons was the premier originating point.

**Iron Ore**

Iron ore sales to other countries in 1967 totalled 383 million dollars; domestic imports were valued at almost \$33 million.

Of the 34,054,081 tons transported by water, the United States was the destination of 25.16 million tons, most of which was loaded at Sept-Îles-Pointe Noire and Port Cartier. Ontario ports exported 4,166,036 tons compared to 4,047,186 tons in 1966; ore through Port Arthur-Fort William constituted a major factor in reversing the downward trend reported by Ontario ports since 1964. The United Kingdom received 3.2 million tons, Italy 1.8 million, the Netherlands 1.4 million and West Germany 0.6 million. On the West Coast, 1,939,247 tons, up 50,000 were sent to Japan. Sept-Îles-Pointe Noire was the leading ore-transfer complex, handling 18,467,021 tons in 1967 and 16,934,951 tons in 1966.

Inward ore at Canadian ports from abroad continued to fall in favour of domestic supplies; 2,992,153 tons were unloaded in 1967 (mainly at Hamilton) representing a 40 per cent drop from the previous year.

Domestic ore traffic advanced to 6,015,876 tons from 4,468,157 tons in 1966. Ore for Sault Ste Marie through the Lakehead jumped to 882,000 tons from 501,000, while Hamilton receipts from Sept-Îles-Pointe Noire stood at 2.8 million against two million tons in the previous year. Titanium ore from Havre St. Pierre to Sorel was much higher at 1,761,155 tons due to uninterrupted mining operations.

**Coal**

The 1,159,427 ton coal shipment from Vancouver to Japan was valued at \$13.3 million, whereas Canadian purchases of bituminous coal totalled \$139 million, all from the United States. An improvement will be realized with growing Japanese Sales.

The year's imports, mostly on the Great Lakes, slid to 15,221,756 tons from 15,654,652 tons unloaded in 1966. Requirements at Hamilton, Port Credit and Toronto rose to a total of 8,150,105 tons from 7,192,778 tons in 1966, while the other two major centres, Sault Ste Marie at 2,144,753 tons, and Windsor at 831,578 tons, were down from 2,303,619 tons and 1,033,885 tons respectively.

Movements of Canadian coal centered on Sydney which shipped 1,041,378 tons, mostly to Toronto-Port Credit, Quebec City and Trois-Rivières. Lesser quantities to the Great Lakes brought the total down 300,000 tons, or near the 1965 level.

**Gypsum**

Gypsum exports were down eighteen per cent to 3,862,730 tons in 1967 due to a drop in American requirements. All but 329,000 tons originated in Nova Scotia, particularly from Halifax and Hantsport. Mexican gypsum into New Westminster and Victoria totalled 65,068 tons, accounting for practically all imports.

Domestic gypsum movements tumbled almost 70,000 to 326,968 tons in 1967, with less to the Great Lakes.

#### Newsprint

Newsprint paper is one of the cornerstones of Canada's foreign trade, and in 1967 exports were valued at \$955,000,000.

Waterborne shipments aggregated 3,544,401 tons during the year, 3,862,629 tons in 1966 and 3,393,739 tons in 1965. The United States is by far the largest market for this commodity, accepting 2,409,623 tons through 1967 and 2,740,592 tons in the previous year. Several factors, including newspaper dissolutions and strikes coupled with growth in American newsprint capacity will have their effect on Canadian producers.

The United Kingdom is next in importance ordering 387,448 tons in 1967 and 379,158 tons in 1966. Australia purchased roughly half that amount for a dollar value of 22 million. The heaviest movements originated at Corner Brook (359,822 tons), Quebec (338,308 tons), Baie Comeau (314,129 tons), Port Alberni (298,832 tons), and Powell River (273,496 tons).

Coastal activity was 14,000 lower at 377,245 tons for 1967. Most of this traffic is on the West Coast into Vancouver from Powell River, Campbell River and Ocean Falls.

#### Fuel Oil

Incoming kerosene, diesel and fuel oil represented a dollar value of 112 million. Waterborne imports during the year increased to 8,422,120 tons from 7,850,162 tons in 1966.

Of this volume 31.6 per cent or 2,662,072 tons originated in Venezuela, and a further 44.2 per cent or 3,728,637 tons from the Netherlands Antilles. In the previous year these two areas supplied 6,186,266 tons or 78.8 per cent. Of the numerous communities receiving this commodity, Montreal led with 1,821,147 tons, being followed by Quebec at 880,735 tons and Halifax at 803,906 tons; only the latter port recorded an increase. Some 192,819 tons were transported from Canada to the United States, St. Pierre and Miquelon.

Domestic traffic at 7,814,527 tons was lower, but within a percentage point of the 1966 volume. The commodity is widely dispersed, the major distributing centres being Montreal (2,320,975 tons), Halifax (1,323,697 tons), Sarnia (1,243,091 tons), Vancouver (990,224 tons), Saint John (634,969 tons), and Clarkson (304,195 tons). Of this group only Halifax reported gains.






