OIL PIPE LINE TRANSPORT

JUNE, 1961

Canadian oil pipe lines received a total of 25,790,897 barrels of crude oil, liquefied petroleum gases and petroleum products during June, 1961. This was a 6.8 per cent increase from the previous year's total of 24,150,638 barrels. The month's receipts were comprised of 18,180,935 barrels of domestic crude oil and L.P.G.'s, 4,181,780 barrels of imported crude oil, L.P.G.'s and products and 3,428,182 barrels of products.

During the month the oil pipe line industry delivered 25,560,030 barrels of petroleum and its products (852,001 barrels per day), an increase of 5.5 per cent over the preceding year's total of 24,218,304 barrels. The deliveries included 16,159,798 barrels of domestic crude oil and L.P.G.'s, 5,943,844 barrels of crude oil, L.P.G.'s and products for export and 3,456,388 barrels of products.

Trunk line net receipts rose 16.2 per cent above June, 1960. Gathering systems accounted for 69.4 per cent of the receipts. Imports of 4,181,780 barrels were down 22.8 per cent from the previous year and accounted for 15.2 per cent of the receipts.

Deliveries to refineries decreased 5.6 per cent, exports increased 71.4 per cent to 5,943,844 barrels and deliveries to bulk plants and terminals rose 8.0 per cent. Total oil held by Canadian pipe line systems amounted to 12,827,068 barrels at the end of the month, an increase of 1.5 per cent.

Total traffic of trunk lines amounted to 12,232,349 barrel miles while the average length of haul was 298.4 miles.

Operating revenues for the first half of the year increased \$4,071,881 or 8.4 per cent to 52,479,-

Employees numbered 1,541 in June and earned \$803,975 as compared with 1,605 employees earning \$820,681 in June 1960.

This is the sixth Oil Pipe Line Transport report based on new reporting forms for the responding companies. The companies are asked to report all receipts and deliveries of oil and to account for all oil handled. All duplications resulting from the transfer of oil from one pipe line company to another are removed. Totals are therefore total unduplicated receipts or deliveries. To give some indication of the volume of intercompany transfers these items are also carried and enter into the gross totals, i.e. totals including duplications. Oil used as "fuel" has been separated from "losses and unaccounted for" and have been entered as individual items. Inventory and other changes which include changes in "inventory held in bond in the United States" are also segregated.

Comparisons between the new series and the old are given. The operations of the pipe lines are divided by product and type of operation.

New categories of receipts and deliveries that are used include the following:

Transfers from L.P.G.'s to (or from) crude oil stream are to account for condensate and liquefied petroleum gases which are mixed into the crude oil and are no longer recorded separately.

Deliveries and receipts from bulk plants and terminals are points of receipt and delivery of refined petroleum products and also include receipts from gas processing plants.


