OIL PIPE LINE TRANSPORT

JULY, 1961

Canadian oil pipe lines received a total of 26,214,752 barrels of crude oil, liquefied petroleum gases and petroleum products during July, 1961. This was a 1.3 per cent decrease from the 26,513,409 barrels reported one year earlier but an increase of 1.6 per cent above the 25,790,857 barrels received in the previous month. The receipts were comprised of 18,981,428 barrels of crude oil and L.P.G.'s, 3,883,772 barrels of imported crude oil and products and 3,349,552 barrels of products.

Deliveries of petroleum and its products increased 0.6 per cent during the month to 25,832,107 barrels from 25,675,694 barrels in July, 1960. Included in the deliveries were 16,367,163 barrels of crude oil and L.P.G.'s, 6,092,423 barrels of crude oil, L.P.G.'s and products for export and 3,372,521 barrels of products.

Trunk line net receipts rose 8.6 per cent to 27,759,380 barrels from 25,571,879 barrels received in the same period in 1960. Own gathering systems accounted for 44.9 per cent of receipts with 26.4 per cent received from other gathering systems. Imports of 3,883,772 barrels were down 45.4 per cent from last year and accounted for 14.0 per cent of the receipts.

Although deliveries to refineries and plants declined from July 1960, an increase in exports (2,618,494 barrels) resulted in total deliveries being virtually unchanged. Total oil held by Canadian pipe line systems amounted to 12,891,512 barrels at the end of the month.

Total traffic of trunk lines increased 27.1 per cent to 12,054,546 barrel miles from 9,482,925 barrels in July, 1960, while the average length of haul was 291.9 miles.

Employment and earnings continued to decline during, July with 1,530 employees earning \$824,419 as against 1,616 employees earning \$828,529 one year ago.

Net receipts (and deliveries) are the unduplicated totals of oil received (and delivered) by the Canadian oil pipeline systems. Intercompany movements of oil are tabulated separately as transfers. In addition condensates or L.P.G.'s which are "transferred to crude oil stream", that is comingled with oil, are entered separately. L.P.G.'s in this report are used to include condensates.
