

His orical File

The amount of oil carried by Canadian pipe lines rose during June to an average of 603,712 barrels per day as compared with an average of 558,974 barrels in May and 487,203 in June of the previous year, an increase of 8.0 and 23.9 per cent, respectively.

Total net deliveries for the month of June aggregated 18,111,357 barrels as against 17,328,184 barrels in May and 14,616,093 barrels in June, 1954. For the six months ended June 30, net deliveries totalled 103,662,064 barrels, an increase of 20,016,-561 barrels or 23.9 per cent over the 1954 total of 83,645,503 barrels. Deliveries by provinces to the end of June were as follows with similar data for 1954 in brackets: British Columbia, 13,354,047 barrels (6,191,168); Alberta, 8,345,927 barrels (7,974,481); Saskatchewan, 7,767,819 barrels (6,665,222); Manitoba, 23,228,643 barrels (19,083,158); Ontario, 18,376,834 barrels (15,974,647); and, Quebec 32,588,794 barrels (27,756,827). Manitoba deliveries included 19,658,576 barrels (15,923,657) transferred to the Lakehead Pipe Line Company for transport through the United States, principally to Sarnia refineries. The remainder 3,570,067 barrels (3,159,501) were delivered within the province.

Net receipts during June amounted to 18,249,761 barrels as compared with 14,222,-363 barrels in the same month last year, an increase of 4,027,398 barrels or 28.3 per cent. Included in the receipts for June were 9,163,735 barrels of Alberta crude, 42,565 of Alberta natural gasoline, 497,015 of Saskatchewan crude, 340,516 of Manitoba crude, 5,483,-573 of imported crude and 2,722,357 barrels of refinery products.

Both gathering and trunk lines handled more oil than in the previous month. Gathering systems handled an average of 313,442 barrels per day as against 279,280 barrels in May, a gain of 12.2 per cent. Trunk lines handled an average of 776,073 barrels per day, 8.4 per cent above the May average of 715,726 barrels. Barrel miles rose to 6,797 million compared with 6,550 in May and 5,569 million in June 1954.

Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company and Anglo Canadian Oils, Ltd. have been omitted. Data on the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.




