

Historical File Copy

The amount of oil carried by Canadian pipe lines reached a new high in July with a net delivery of 19,699,144 barrels as compared with 14,793,202 barrels in July, 1954. Daily deliveries totalled 635,456 barrels, 5.2 per cent above the 603,712 barrels delivered in June and 33.2 per cent above the 477,200 barrels delivered in July 1954.

Total net deliveries for the seven months ended July 31, 1955 were 123,361,208 barrels, compared with 98,438,705 barrels recorded in the same period last year. Provincial deliveries for the seven months are as follows (1954 data in brackets) British Columbia, 16,000,828 barrels (7,229,544); Alberta, 10,093,215 (9,491,131); Saskatchewan, 9,250,821 (8,004,818); Manitoba, 28,278,821 (23,208,729); Ontario, 21,406,919 (18,545,494); and Quebec, 38,330,604 (31,958,989). Deliveries in Manitoba included 24,005,230 barrels (19,419,662) transferred from the Interprovincial system to the Lakehead Pipe Line Company for shipment through the United States to Sarnia.

Net receipts for the month amounted to 20,348,912 barrels as compared with 15,253,365 in 1954 an increase of 33.4 per cent. Included in July receipts were 10,530,798 barrels of Alberta crude, 40,880 barrels of Alberta natural gasoline, 381,580 of Manitoba crude, 558,973 of Saskatchewan crude, 5,760,943 of imported crude and 3,075,738 barrels of refinery products.

Gathering systems handled an average of 352,818 barrels compared with 313,442 barrels in June an increase of 12.5 per cent. Trunk lines rose to 826,378 in July from 776,073 in June.

Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company, Anglo Canadian Oils, Ltd. and Valley Pipe Line Company, Ltd. have been omitted. Data on the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.


