Total net deliveries of oil from Canadian pipe lines during August averaged 646,911 barrels per day, compared with 635,456 barrels in July and 450,859 barrels in August 1954.

Net deliveries for the eight months ended August 31, 1955 were 143,415,453 barrels compared with 112,415,352 during the same period last year, an increase of 27.6 per cent. Refinery Products amounted to 17.3 per cent of the total or 24,871,888 barrels as against 21,094,220 in 1954. Provincial deliveries to the end of August were as follows, (1954 data in brackets); British Columbia, 18,837,746 (8,527,734); Alberta, 11,904,927 (11,126,965); Saskatchewan, 10,749,905 (9,285,685); Manitoba, 33,267,464 (27,211,139); Ontario, 24,468,378 (20,960,899); Quebec, 44,187,033 (35,302,930), Manitoba deliveries included 28,453,468 (27,211,139) barrels delivered to the Lakehead Pipe Line Company at Gretna and 4,813,996 (4,400,669) delivered within the province.

Net receipts during August totalled 19,953,257 barrels compared with 14,103,-923 in the same month of 1954. Included in the month's receipts were 9,882,073 barrels of Alberta crude and 43,393 of Alberta natural gasoline 624,121 of Saskatchewan crude, 407,111 of Manitoba crude 5,877,900 imported crude and 3,118,659 barrels of refinery products.

Gathering lines handled an average of 338,480 barrels per day against 352,-818 in July and 215,740 in August last year an increase of 56.9 per cent over the previous year. Trunk lines handled 825,255 barrels per day in August against 826,378 in July and 555,639 in August 1954.

Employment was up from 1,307 in July to 1,336 in August, and salaries and wages rose from \$528,951 in July to \$534,746 in August.

Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company, Anglo Canadian Oils, Ltd. and Valley Pipe Line Company, Ltd. have been omitted. Data on the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.


