PIPE LINES (OIL) STATISTICS

MARCH, 1957.

Total net deliveries of oil through Canadian pipe lines during March averaged 836,387 barrels per day, a slight decrease from the February average of 852,889, but an increase of 13.5 p.c. over the March 1956 average of 736,710 barrels.

Net deliveries from both gathering and trunk lines for the first quarter ended March 31, amounted to 76,963,416 barrels compared with 67,432,575 in the same period last year, an increase of 14.1 p.c. Provincial deliveries for the first three months of the year were as follows: (1956 data in brackets): British Columbia 16,756,543 barrels (11,189,261); Alberta 3,010,240 barrels (4,992,349); Saskatchewan 4,590,066 barrels (4,437,831); Manitoba 19,309,949 barrels (16,920,079); Ontario 13,046,322 barrels (11,217,553) and Quebec 20,250,-296 barrels (18,675,502). Included in Manitoba deliveries were 16,570,623 barrels (14,314,934) transferred to the Lake Head Pipe Line Company at Gretna. Of this 5,591,147 barrels were for export while the remainder moved through the United States destined to refineries at Sarnia. Exports via the Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line are shown in a footnote to table 4 and include all deliveries at dock for export.

Net receipts for the month of March totalled 26,192,601 barrels, an increase of 13.0 p.c. over the 23,185,036 barrels received in the same month last year. March receipts included 12,157,218 barrels of Alberta crude and 54,787 of Alberta natural gasoline, 2,474,783 barrels of Saskatchewan crude, 507,178 barrels of Manitoba crude, 6,756,625 of imported crude and 4,242,010 barrels of refinery products.

Gathering systems handled an average of 464,906 barrels per day as compared with 471,147 in February and 411,726 in March 1956. Trunk lines dropped to a daily average of 1,187,329 in the current month from 1,217,685 last month and 1,001,129 one year earlier.

Barrel miles rose to 10,705 million from 9,332 in March 1956, an increase of 14.7 p.c., but the average haul decreased slightly from 300.7 to 290.8 miles.

Operating revenues for the first quarter of the year amounted to \$23,155,115 as compared with \$18,372,225 for the three months ending March 31, 1956, an increase of \$4.782,890 or 26.0 p.c.

Prepared in the Transportation and Public Utilities Section, Public Finance and Transportation Division. Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company, Anglo Canadian Oils, Ltd. and Valley Pipe Line Company, Ltd. have been omitted. Data on the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.

Net totals given in Table 6 exceed those in Tables 1 and 2 because of duplications resulting from inter-company transfers of oil. These differences are accounted for in the following table.

The Interprovincial Pipe Line Company operates over 1,500 miles of line in Canada from Edmonton to the International border near Gretna, Manitoba, along with 7 miles of 30 inch pipe coming into Canada across the St. Clair River at Sarnia. The Sun Pipe Line Company also operates lines across the St. Clair River from the United States to Sarnia. Oil delivered at Sarnia via Interprovincial's line would be a duplication of oil already reported on the western section of the line. For this reason and because of the limited nature of their operations data for these two short sections are not included in Canadian oil pipe line statistics. A summary of oil delivered by these two lines at Sarnia follows:


