PIPE LINES (OIL) STATISTICS

APRIL, 1957

Total net deliveries of oil from Canadian pipe lines amounted to 24,331,185 barrels for the month of April. This was a daily average of 811,039 barrels as compared with an average of 836,387 in the previous month, a drop of 25,348 barrels or 3.0 p.c.

For the four months ended April 30, net deliveries amounted to 101,294,601 barrels, an increase of 14.6 p.c. above deliveries of 88,422,928 recorded in the same period of 1956. Of this total, refinery products accounted for 16,922,346 barrels, as against 15,251,963 in 1956. Provincial deliveries for the first four months were as follows. (1956 data in brackets): British Columbia 22,773,359 barrels (13,873,230); Alberta 3,-967,224 barrels (6,446,283); Saskatchewan 5,794,005 barrels (5,832,779); Manitoba 24,965,-728 barrels (22,538,245); Ontario 16,658,950 barrels (14,934,494); and Quebec 27,135,335 barrels (24,797,897). Included in Manitoba deliveries were 21,334,307 barrels (16,570,623) transferred to the Lake Head Pipe Line Company at Gretna. Of this 7,166,009 barrels were for export while the remainder moved through the United States destined to refineries at Sarnia. Exports via the Trans Mountain Oil Pipe Line are shown in a footnote to table 4 and include all deliveries at dock for export.

For the month of April net receipts totalled 25,345,951 barrels down slightly from the March receipts of 26,192,601 but an increase of 19.6 p.c. above the April, 1956 receipts of 21,197,428 barrels. Included in the April receipts were 11,919,785 barrels of Alberta crude and 50,867 of Alberta natural gasoline, 2,317,372 barrels of Saskatchewan crude, 460,316 of Manitoba crude, 6,913,332 barrels of imported crude and 3,684,279 barrels of refinery products.

Gathering systems handled an average of 472,706 barrles per day in April, an increase of 30 p.c. over the corresponding month last year, when 363,061 barrels were handled. Trunk line deliveries at 24,151,699 barrels dropped slightly from last month, but increased by 29 p.c. over the daily average of 699,678 in April 1956.

Barrel miles at 9,971 million, were down slightly from 10,705 in March, and the average length of haul fell from 290.8 miles to 285.3.

Employment reached a new high in the month under review, with 1,687 employees earning \$775,673, as compared with 1,402 employees in April 1956 with total salaries of \$608,866.

Revenue and employee data for the Sarnia Products Pipe Line Division of Imperial Oil, Ltd. are not available for this report as the pipe line operation forms only a part of the company's activities and is not separable. For the same reason revenue and employee data of the pipe line operation of the Anglo American Exploration Company and employee data of the Amurex Oil Development Company, Key Pipe Line Company, Ltd., Mid-Saskatchewan Pipe Lines, Ltd., Nisku Products Pipe Line Company, Anglo Canadian Oils, Ltd. and Valley Pipe Line Company, Ltd. have been omitted. Data on the activities of these companies have been included in all other applicable sections of the report.

The Interprovincial Pipe Line Company operates over 1,500 miles of line in Canada from Edmonton to the International border near Gretna, Manitoba, along with 7 miles of 30 inch pipe coming into Canada scross the St. Clair River at Sarnia. The Sun Pipe Line Company also operates lines across the St. Clair River from the United States to Sarnia. Oil delivered at Sarnia via Interprovincial's line would be a duplication of oil already reported on the western section of the line. For this reason and because of the limited nature of their operations data for these two short sections are not included in Canadian oil pipe line statistics. A summary of oil delivered by these two lines at Sarnia follows:


